An Act for amending and widening the Road, from the City of York, by Grimston Smithy, to Kexby Bridge, and from Grimston Smithy aforefaid, to a certain Gate at the upper End of Garraby Hill, in the County of York.

An Act for repairing and widening the Road, from Stockport, in the County of Chefter, to Samon's-Lane-End, in the County of Lancaster, and from the Gross in Ashton-under-Line, in the said County of Lancaster, to Doctor's-Lane-Head, in the County of York; and alfo the Road branching out of the first-mentioned Road, in the Township of Bredbury, to Mottram, in the faid County of Chefter.

An Act to amend several Acts, passed in the Fourth and Sixth Years of King George the First, and in the Eleventh and Twenty-fourth Years of King George the Second, for repairing feveral Roads from the Stones End, in Kent Street, and Bermondfey Street, Southwark, to Dartford, and to the Extent of the Parish of Lewisham, next Brownley and Beckenham, in the County of Kent ; and for extending the faid Acts to the Repair of the Roads leading from the End of the prefent Turnpike, to the West End of Stroud Green, and to Farnborough Well, and to the Stones End, in London Street, Greenwich ; and to the North End of Burnt Ash Lane, in the Parish of Lee; and from the West End of Greenwich Park Wall, to Woolwich Warren; and for making Allowance, out of the Tolls arifing by the faid Acts, to the Trustees, for putting in Execution an Act of the Twenty Second Year of King George the Second, for opening and making a new Road from the East End of New Street, in the Parish of Saint John Southwark, to and through the feveral Places therein-mentioned, and for keeping the faid Road in Repair for the future.

An Act for repairing and widening the Roads from the Little Bridge, over the End of the Drain, next Wisbeach River, lying between Roper's Fields, and the Bell Inn in Wisbeach, in the Isle of Ely, to the Sign of the Bear, in Walfoken, in the County of Norfolk; and from Walfoken Bridge (lying over the faid Drain) to the faid Sign of the Bear, and to Lord's Bridge in Ifington, and from thence to the West Ends of Maudling Bridge and German's Bridge in the Output of W Bridge, in the County of Norfolk; and from the East End of German's Bridge aforesaid, to the West End of Long Bridge, in South Lynn, in the Borough of King's Lynn, in the faid County of Norfolk; and from Islington aforefaid, to Cross Keys Wash, in the faid County.

An Act for repairing, widening, turning, alter-ing, and keeping in Repair, the Roads leading from the Port-Town and Borough of Minehead, through Dunster and Timberscombe, to Hele Bridge, and through the Town of Dulverton, and by the River and Brushford Green, to Exbridge, in the County of Somerfet, and from thence to Batham Bridge, in the Town of Bampton, in the County of Devon; and also the Road leading from the faid Port-Town and Borough of Minehead, through Carbampton and Billbrooke, to Hartrow Gate, in the Parish of Stogumber, in the County of Somerfet ; and also the Road leading from Carhampton aforefaid, through the Town of Watchet, in the Parish of Saint Decumans, in the County of Somerfet, to or near the Village of Rydon, and by Long Cross Barn, to the End of the Bridgewater Turnpike Road, in the Town of Nether Stowey, in the County of Somerset; and also from the said Town of Watchet to Tower Hill, in the Village of Williton, in the faid Parish of Saint Decumans, and from the faid Town of Watchet, by way of of the Poor, in the Hundreds of Loes and Wilford, Five Bells, to Fair Cross, and from thence to Stickle Path, over Brendon Hill, to Robery Lane, and to Bambton. in the faid County of Devon.

An AET for repairing and widening feveral Roads, leading from between the Second and Third Mile Stones, on the Turnpike Road between the Town and County of Poole, and Winborne-Minfler, in the County of Dorfet, to Braiton Gorner, in the County of Somerset.

An Act for repairing and widening the Road, leading from a Street called The Hundred, at Romsey, through Chilworth, to the River at Swathling, in the County of Southampton, and for connesting the fame with the Road leading from the City of Winchester, through Hurstey, to Chandler's Ford; and from Hurstey aforefaid, to the Turnpike Road at Romfey, aforefaid; and alfo for repairing and widening the Road leading from the River at Swathling aforefaid, through Botley, to the Turnpike Road at Sherril Heath, in the faid County of Southampton.

An Act for repairing and widening the Road from Alford to Boston, and from thence to Cow--bridge, in the County of Lincoln.

An Act to enlarge the Term and Powers of an Act, made in the Twenty-feventh Year of His late Majesty, for opening, making, widening, and keeping in Repair, a Road, from Ratcliffs Higbway, through Gannon Street, in the County of Middlefex, and other Roads in the faid All men-tioned; and for lighting, watching, and watering, the faid Roads.

An Act for enlarging the Term and Powers granted by an Act, paffed in the Twenty-fixth Year of His late Majesty's Reign, intituled, An AEt for repairing and widening the Roads therein mentioned, leading to and from the Towns of Shepton Mallet and Ivelchefter, in the County of Somerfet; and for repairing the Roads from Shepton Mallee to Leighton, and from Shepton Mallet to Long Cross Bottom.

An AET for repairing and widening the Road from the Alfreton Turnpike Road, near a Place called Little Robins, in the Parish of Mansfield, in the County of Nottingham, through Woolley Moor, to the Nottingham Turnpike Road, near Tanfley, in the County of Derby, and from Woolley Moor, to the Chefterfield Turnpike Road at Kelstridge, in the County of Derby.

An Act for explaining and amending, and likewife for enlarging the Term and Powers granted by a certain All of Parliament, passed in the Twenty-fifth Year of the Reign of His late Majefty King George the Second, intituled, An Act for amending Several Roads leading from the Town of Taunton, in the County of Somerfes.

An Att to enlarge certain Powers granted by an Act, passed in the Twenty-second Year of the Reign of King George the Second, intituled, An Act for enlarging and maintaining the Harbour of Ramfgate; and for cleanfing, amending, and preferving, the Haven of Sandwich.

An AEE for vesting certain Glebe Lands, be-longing to the Restory of the Parish Church of Saint Christopher in the City of London, in the Governor and Company of the Bank of England ; and for making a Recompence to the Rector of the faid Parish, and his Successors, in Lieu thereof; and for obviating certain Doubts, in an AEt passed in the Thirty-third Year of the Reign of His late Majesty, for widening certain Streets, Lanes, and Passages, within the City of London.

An Att for repairing the Church of the United -Parishes of All Saints and Saint John, in the Town of Hertford.

An Act for the better Relief and Employment in the County of Suffolk.
