UBLICK Notice is hereby given, That by an Act passed the last Session of Parliament, For altering certain Rates of Postage, and for amending, explaining, and enlarging several Pro-visions in the Act of the Ninth of Queen Anne, and other Acts relating to the Post-Office;' It is, amongst other Things, Enacted,

That Letters between London and any Port within the British Dominions in America, (in which all His Migery's West-India Islands are included) shall pay Single One shilling, Double Two Shillings, Treble

Three Saillings, the Ounce Four Shillings.

That Letters, by Sea, from any one Port to any other Port within the faid Dominions, shall pay Sin-

gle Four Pence, Double Eight Pence, Treble One Snilling, the Ounce One Shilling and Four Pence. That Letters, by Land, to or from any Chief Fost-Office in America; from or to any other Part thereof not exceeding Sixty Miles from such Chief Post Office, or from the Office where such Letters, not passing through a Ilief Office, may be put in, shall pay Single Four Pence. Double Eight Pence, Treble One Shilling, the Ounce One Shilling and Four Pence. And being upwards of Sixty, and not exceeding One Hundred Mile: within the faid Domissions, shalt pay Single Six Pence, Double One Shilling, Treble One Shilling and Six Pence, the Ounce Two chillings And being apwards of One Hundred, and not exceeding Thus Applied Miles mission to fail I was a seeding Thus Applied Miles mission to fail I was seeding Two Hundred Miles within the faid Domi-

nions, shall pay Single Eight Pence, Double One Shilling and Four Pence, Treble Two Skillings, the Ounce Two Shillings and Eight Pence. And to every Distance not exceeding One Hundred Miles above such Two Hundred, and for every such further Distance within the said Dominions, shall pay Single Two Pence, Double Four Pence, Treble Six

Pence, the Ounce Eight Pence.

That no Vessel shall be permitted to break Bulk, or make Entry in any Port within the British Dominions, where Posts are or may be established, until all Letters on board are delivered to the Pollmaster of fuch Port (he paying the Bringer One Penny for each Letter) to be forwarded according to their respective Directions, except such as are excepted by the Act of the Ninth of Queen Anne; and such as ma be brought by Vessels liable to Quarentine, which last are to be delivered to the Persons superintending the Quarentine, for proper Care, before they are forwarded by the Polt. And that all Walters, Mariners. Passengers, &c. neglecting to deliver the Letters as aforesaid, shall, for every Neglect, forseit Twenty

That the Postmaster shall take for every Letter brought by fuch Vessel, for any Pi ce within his Delivery, One Penny, above the Penny paid to the

Mailer or other Person for the same.

That Letters conveyed in Great Britain and Ireland, not exceeding one Stage, thall pay Sing'e One Penny, Double Two Pence, Treble Three Pence, the Ounce Four Pence. And in England, above one and not exceeding two Stages, Single Two Pence, Double Four Pence, Treble Six Pence, the Ounce Eight Pence; but these Rates are not to affect the Penny-

That Letters passing between England and Inlands through Carlifle, Dumfries, Port Patrick, and Dinugbades, shall pay the same Races of English, Scotch Irish, and Packet Pollage, according to the Dillance or Number of Stages they are conveyed in each Kingdom, as are fettled by the Att of the Ninth of Queen Anne, or by this Act.

That no Packet exceeding the Weight of Four Ounces shall be sent by the Fenny rost; unless com= ing from, or passing thereby to the General Post.

That Letters passing between London and Hamburgh shall pay as Letters between London and all other Parts of German, viz. Single One Shilling, Double Two Shillings, Treble Three Shillings, the Oonce Four Shillings.

That any Officer of the Post-Office secreting or destroying any Letter, Bag or Mail of Letters, containing any Bank Note, Bill, or other Paper, Writing, or Order for the Payment of Money; or dealing out of any Letter any feeh Bank Note Bill, &c.

on Conviction, shall suffer Death as a Fewn
That any Person robbing a Mail, in any Place or in any Manner whatfoaver, although it a comme appear that any one was put in Fear by Sich Robbery, shall, on Conviction, such as Death as a Felon.
That any Officer of the Pol Office, entitled to

take in Letters, and receive the Postage the eo., embezzling the Money receiven, or deflioying the Letters; or any Officer advancing the Rajes on Letters, and not accounting for the advances Pollage, thell,

on Conviction, he deemed gottey of Fermi.

That any Post-Loy having a Mail or Eng of Letters under his Care, deferting the fame before his Arrival at the next Stage; or fuffeling any other Perion to ride on the Horse or Carriage along therewith:
