titurdred Miles within the faid Dominions, hall pay Single Six Pence, Double One Shilling, Treble One Shilling and Six Pence, the Ounce Two Shillings. And being upwards of One Hundred, and not exceeding Two flundred Miles within the faid Dominions, hall! pay Single Eight Pence, Double One Shlling and Four Pence, Treble Two Shillings, the Ounce Two Shillings and Eight Pence. And for every Diftance not exceeding One Hundred Miles above fuch Two Hlundred, and for every fuch further Diftance within the faid Dominions, fhall pay Single Twa Pence, Double Four Pence, Treble Six Pence, the Ounce Eight Pence.

That no Veffel fhall to permitted to break Bulk, or make Entry in any Port within the Britifb Dominions, where Pofts are or may be cftablifined, until ail Letters on board are delivered to the Poftmatter of Iuch Port (he paying the Bringer One Penny for each Ietter) to be forwarded according to their refpective Directions, except fach as are excepted by the Att of the Niath of Queen Anre; and fuch as may be brought by Veffels liable to Quarentine, which laft are to b ? delivered to the Perfons fuperintending the Quarentine, for proper Care, before they are forwarced by the Poft. And that all Mafters, Mariners, Paftengers, \&c. reglecting to deliver the Letters as forefaid, Chail, for every Neglect, forfeir Twenty Pounds.

That the Poftmafter fhall take for every Letter brought by fuch Veffel, for any Place within his Delivery, One Penny, above the Penny paid to the Malter or other Perfon for the fame.

That Letters conveyed in Great Britain and Ireland, not exceeding one Stage, flall pay Single One Penny, Double Two Pence, Treble Three Pence, the Ounce Four Pence: And in England, above one and not exceeding two Stages, Single Two Pence, Dou. ble Four Pence, Treble Six Pence, the Ounce Eitht Pence ; but thefe Rates are not to affect the PennyPo?

That Letters paffing between England and Ireland, birough Carlifle, Dumfries, Port Patrick, and Donaghadee, hall pay the fame Rates of Englijh, Scotch, Irijof and Packet Poltage, according to the Diftance or Number of Stages they are conveyed. in each Kingdom, as are fottled by the Act of the Ninth of Queen Anne, or by this Aft.

That no Packet exceeding the Weight of Four Ounces fhall be fent by the Penny. Poft; unlefs com-突g from, or paffing thereby to the General-Poft.

That Letters palfing beween London and Ham'urgh thall pay as Letters between London and all other Parts of Germany, viz. Single One Shilling, Double Two Shillings, Treble Three Shillings, the Ounce Four Shillings.

That any Officer of the Pofl-Offiee fecreting or deftroying any Letter, Bag or Mail of Letters, containing any Bank Note, Bill, or other Paper, Wriing, or Order for the Payment of Money ; or fealing out of any Letter any fuch Bank Nore, Bill, \&e. on Conviction, thall fuffer Dearh as a Felon.

That any Perfon robbing a Mail, in any Place or in any Manner whatfoever, although it may not appear that any one was put in Fear by fuch Robbery, thall, on Conviction, fuffer Death as a Felon.

That any Officer of the Poft-Office, entrufted to talke in Letters, and seceive the Poftage thereof, em-
tiezeling the Mioney received, or deftroying the Lés ters; © $\quad$ any Oflicer advancing the Rates on Letters, and not accounting for the advanced Pollage, fhall; on Conviction; be deemed guilty of Felony.

That any Poft-Boy having a Mail or Bag of Letters under his Care, deferting the fame before his Atrival at the next Stage; or fuffering any other Perfon to ride on the Horfe or Carriage along therswith; or loitering on the Road; or nor, in all poflible Cafes, conveying the Mail after the Rate of Six meafured Miles an Hour, fhall, on Conviction, before one Juttice of the Peace, be fent to the Houfe of Correction for any Time not exceeding One Month, nor lefs than Fourteen Days.

That any Pont-Boy, fingly, or in Combination' with others; unlawfully coffecting, or conveying Letters, or causing the fame to be unlawfolly conveyed, ihall, on Convigtion, before one Jultice of the Pcace, forfeit Ten Shillings, to be paid to the Informer, for every Letter so unlawfully collected; conveyed, or delivered. And if the Forfeiture is not immediately paid, fhafl be fent to the Houfs of Correction, for any 'Time not exceeding Two Monshs, nor lefs than One Month

That all Raies of Letters, and all Forfeitures, mentioned in this Act, fhall be paid in Sterling Mos. ney of Great Britain.

The Rates eftablithed by this Act for the Port of Letters between London and Hambargh; and the Limitation of the Weight of Packets to be fent by the Penny-Poft, commence from the Fifth of $7 u l y$ next. All other Regulations, Rates of Poftage, Painss Penalties, and Forfeitures berorementioned, com= mence from the Tentb Day of Ofrober next.
