Vienna, October 2: HE Empress Queen appeared in Publick on Monday last for the first Time; and this Morning the gave private Audiences to all the Ambaffadors here.

M. Renieri, the new Venetian Ambaflador that fucceeds M. d'Erizzo, who, according to the usual Rotation, removes to the Embaffy of Rome, had on Monday last his first Audience of the Emperor, and this Morning of the Empress Queen.

Dresden, October 9. Abbé Count Laudron was, three Days ago, declared Grand Maitre to Prince Anthony, fecond Brother to the Elector.

Drefden. October 15. Laft Week Prince Lubo mirski was, with the usual Ceremony, put in Possefion of the Regiment of Guards, which he bought of Count Bruhl, the late Minister's eldeft Son.

The Administrator has for this Week past been troubled with a Fever and Cold; but his Royal Highness will appear again in Publick this Day.

Berlin, October 12. His Royal Highness Prince Henry of Pruffia is returned from Potzdom to his Country Seat at Rhinfberg. The Prince Royal of Pruffia, with the Prince's his Confort; and the two Princes of Brunfwick in this Service, are fet out from Potzdam for Magdebourg, in order to meet there the Margravine of Bareuth.

To Captains and as ien o Clock in the Morring, With 10 Captains and their Attorneys, and the Officers appearing themfelwes, on the Monday; and to Attorneys of Lieutenants, Mafters and Surgeons, on the Tuefday, (after which the Lift, will be recalled once a Month) that all The Lift's will be recalled only a hours product as Performs may then and there attend to receive what may become payable unto them, and not only bring with them the Affidavit required touching their not baving enjoyed the Benefit of any publick Em-ployment, either at Sea or on Shore, during the Time they are to be paid their Hulf-Pay; but also produce Considered they them begins full cristed to the Ted and Certificates that they have fubscribed to the Test, and taken the Oaths required by Act of Parliament to His prefent Majesty; and in Case any of the said Sea Officers shall not be able to attend themselves to receive their Money, but employ Attorneys for that Purpole, that the faid Attorneys may produce the like Certificates and Affidavits from the Perfons they are employed by.

General Post-Office, June 8, 1765: DUBLICK Notice is hereby given, That by an Act passed the last Session of Parliaments For altering certain Rates of Postage, and 10r " amending, explaining, and enlarging feveral Pro-" vitions in the Act of the Ninih of Queen Anne, " and other Acts relating to the Poft-Office;" It is, amongst other Things, Enacted, That Letters between London and any Port within the Pairid Dominiant in America in which all His

the British Dominions in America, {in which all His Majefty's Weft-India Iflands are included) shalt pay Single One Shilling, Double Two Shillings, Treble

Three Shillings, the Ounce Four Shillings That Letters, by Sea, from any one Port to any other Port within the faid Dominions, shall pay Single Four Pence; Double Eight Pence, Treble One Shilling, the Ounce One Shilling and Four Pence.

That Letters; by Land, to or from any Chief Poff-Office in America, from or to any other Part thereof not exceeding Sixty Miles from fuch Chief Post Office, or from the Office whete fuch Letters, not paffing through a Chief Office, may be put in, shall pay Single Four Pence, Double Eight Pence, Treble One Shilling, the Ounce One Shilling and Four Pence. And being upwards of Sixty, and not exceeding One Hundred Miles within the faid Dominions, shall pay Single Six Pence, Double One Shilling, Treble One Shilling and Six Pence, the Ounce Two Shillings. And being upwards of One Hundred, and not exceeding Two Hundred Miles within the faid Dominions, shall pay Single Eight Pence, Double One Shilling and Four Pence, Treble Two Shillings; the Ounce Two Shillings and Eight Peace. And for every Distance not exceeding One Hundred Miles above fuch Two Hundred, and for every fuch farther Diftance within the faid Dominions, shall pay Single Two Pence, Double Four Pence, Treble Six Pence, the Ounce Eight Pence.

That no Veffel shall be permitted to break Bulk, or make Entry in any Port within the British Dominions, where Polts are or may be established, until all Letters on board are delivered to the Poftmaster of fuch Port (he paying the Bringer One Penny for each Letter) to be forwarded according to their respective Directions, except such as are excepted by the Act of the Ninth of Queen Anne; and fuch as may be brought by Veffels liable to Quarentine, which laft are to be delivered to the Perfons superintending the Quarentine, for proper Care, before they are for-warded by the Post. And that all Masters, Mariners, Passengers, &c. neglecting to deliver the Letters as aforefaid, shall, for every Neglect, forfeit Twenty Pounds.

That the Poltmaster shall take for every Letter brought by fuch Veffel, for any Place within his Delivery, One Penny, above the Penny paid to the Master or other Person for the fame.

That Letters conveyed in Great Britain and Free land, not exceeding one Stage, shall pay Single One Penny, Double Two Pence, Treble Three Pence, the Ounce Four Pence. And in England, above one and not exceeding two Stages, Single Two Pence, Double Four Pence, Treble Six Pence, the Qunce Eight Pence ;
