THIS Day His Majesty came to the House of Peers, and being in His Royal Robes seated on the Throne with the usual Solemnity, Sir Francis Molineux, Knt. Gentleman Usher of the Black Rod, was sent with a Message from His Majesty to the House of Commons, commanding their Attendance in the House of Peers. The Commons being come thither accordingly, His Majesty was pleased to give the Royal Assent to,

An Act for raising a certain Sum of Money, by Loans or Exchequer Bills, for the Service of the Year One Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty-six.

An Act for repealing the Duties granted upon Cyder and Perry, by an Act made in the Third Year of His present Majesty's Reign; and for granting other Duties on Cyder and Perry in lieu thereof; and for more effectually securing the Duties on Cyder and Perry, imposed by several former Acts.

An Act for discontinuing the Use of several Roads, leading into and over Fisherwick Park, in the County of Stafford, and for building and maintaining a Publick Bridge cross the River Tame, at or near Etford Mill Ford, in the said County, and for repairing, and keeping in Repair, the Road from such Bridge, to Hazlemere Gate, in the Road leading through Whittington to Litchfield

An Act to enlarge and continue the Term and Powers granted by an Act passed in the Fourteenth Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Second, intituled, An Act for repairing the Roads from Doncaster, through Ferry Bridges, to the South side of Tadcaster Cross, and also from Ferry Bridge to Weatherby, and from thence to Borough Bridge, in the County of York, as to so much of the said Act as relates to the said Roads from Doncaster, through Ferry Bridge, to the South Side of Tadcaster Cross.

An Act for repairing and widening the Road from Bawtry, in the County of York, to East Markham Common, in the County of Nottingham, and from Little Drayton, to Twijford Bridge, in the said County.

An Act to enlarge the Term and Powers of an Act, made in the Twenty-fifth Year of King George the Second, for repairing the Roads from the North End of Malling-Street, near the Town of Lewes, and other Roads in the County of Sussex; and for amending the Road from the Brail Park Gate, to the West End of the Turnpike Road leading from the Turnpike Road on

Hurst Green, through the Parishes of Etchingam and Burwash, and from the said Brail Park Gate, to the Town of Battell, in the said County.

An Act for repairing and widening the Road from the Cross, or Market-Place, in the Town of Wimborn Minster, to the Cross, or Market Place, in the Town of Blandford Forum, in the County of Dorset.

An Act for building a Bridge cross the River Thames, from Battersea, in the County of Surry, to Chelsea, in the County of Middlesex.

An Act for the Support and Preservation of the Parish Church of Folkestone, and the lower Part of the Town of Folkestone, in the County of Kent.

An Act for the better maintaining, regulating, and employing the Poor, within the Parish of St. Botolph Aldgate, in the City of London.

And to Seventeen Private Bills.

A Resolution and Order of the House of Commons, Jovis 10^o die Aprilis 1766.

RESOLVED,

THAT One Third Part of the remaining Capital Stock of Annuities, after the Rate of Four Pounds per Centum per Annum, granted in Respect of certain Navy, Victualling, and Transport Bills and Ordnance Debentures, delivered in and cancelled, pursuant to an Act of the Third Year of His Majesty's Reign, be redeemed and paid off on the 25th Day of December next; after discharging the Interest then payable in respect of the same.

ORDERED,

That Mr. Speaker do forthwith give Notice, that One Third Part of the remaining Capital Stock of Annuities, after the Rate of Four Pounds per Centum per Annum, granted in respect of certain Navy, Victualling, and Transport Bills and Ordnance Debentures, delivered in and cancelled, pursuant to an Act of the Third Year of His Majesty's Reign, will be redeemed and paid off on the 25th Day of December next, after discharging the Interest then payable in respect of the same, agreeable to the Clauses and Powers of Redemption contained in the said Act.

Which Resolution and Order, thus signified and published by me, are to be sufficient Notice of the Repayment of One Third Part of the principal Sum for which the said Annuities were established, and of the Redemption of so much of the said Annuities as are attending on the said Third Part.
