" Gentlemen this is to give Notis to all poor Sufferers people that Suffer by the hardnes of times and Severnes of people to get themselves ready prepared for a Mob or Sivel war for thear is a Strong Army going to arive from many Parts of the West with a ful reslution to See if we cannot alter the times the farmer that fels his corn and Cattel so dear the Miler and Malter Chees and Backen gobers I have you Confid and lore your pries it will be better for you when trouble Seas your damd hard hearts and angush raks your breast will pull George from his throne beat down the house of rougs and destroy the Sets of the Law makets.

" Pobleth This with Speed"

His Majesty, for the better discovering and bringing to Justice the Persons concerned in Writing the said anonymous, treasonable, and threatening Letter, is hereby pleased to promise His most gracious Pardon to any one of them, (except the Person who actually wrote

the said Letter) who shall discover his or her Accomplice or Accomplices therein, so that he, she, or they may be apprehended and convicted thereof;
