Florence, January 17.

ON the 14th Instant, about Noon, the Great Dutcheſs was happily delivered of a Princeſs; and her Royal Highneſs and the young Princeſs continued as well as poſſible in their preſent Situation. The young Princeſs was chriſtened the ſame Evening by the Names Maria, Teresſa, Giuſeppa, Char-lotta, Giovanna. The Ceremony was performed by the Archbiſhop of Florence, in the Preſence of the Great Duke, who was attended by the Principal Officers of his Court: The Nobility of both Sexes, and the Foreign Miniſters, were invited there on this Occaſion. Count Roſenberg repreſented the Perſon of the Emperor; and Marquis Viviani, the Spaniſh Envoy, that of the King of Spain, as God-Fathers; and the Counteſs Thurn repreſented the Empreſs-Queen, as God-Mother. The next Morning the Great Duke received the Compliments of the Foreign Miniſters, and admitted all the Ranks of the Nobility and the Military Officers to kiſs his Hand on this Occaſion. Three Days Gala were notified, during which the Ladies had Intimation to appear in the Great Dutcheſs's Anti-chamber at Twelve o'Clock, to enquire after her Health. The ſame Hour was appointed for the Foreign Miniſters, to whom the Grande Maitreſſe came out to receive their Compliments, and to give them an Account of the Great Dutcheſs's Health; but this Ceremony, with regard to them, is not limited to any Number of Days. A few Hours after the Great Dutcheſs's Delivery, two Valets de Chambre were diſpatched as Couriers to Vienna and Madrid; and Yeſterday Count Thurn, the Captain of the Guard, ſat out for Vienna, Colonel Capponi for Madrid, Marquis Albizzi for Naples, and Count Montauti for Bruſſels, to acquaint thoſe Courts, in Form, of this Event. By the Empreſs's expreſs Order an Eſtafette, for 20 Days, is to be diſpatched every Morning from hence with an Account of the Great Dutcheſs's Health.
