The Ceremony was performed by the Archb shop of Florence, in the Prefence of the Great Duke, who was attended by the Principal Officers of his Court: The Nobility of both Sexes, and the Foreign Ministers, were invited there on this Occasion. Count Rolenberg represented the Person of the Emperor; and Marquis Viviani, the Spanish Envoy, that of the King of Spain, as God-Fathers; and the Countes Thurn represented the Empres-Queen, as God-Mother. The next Morning the Great Duke, received, the Compliments of the Foreign Ministers, and admitted all the Ranks of the Nobility and the Military Officers tokis his Hand on this Occasion. Three Days Gala were notified, during which the Ladies had Intimation to appear in the Great Dutchess's Anti-chamber at Twelve o'Clock, to enquire after her Health. The same Hour was appointed for the Foreign Ministers, to whom the Grande Mattelle came out to receive their Compliments, and to give them an Account of the Great Dutches's Health; but this Ceremony, with regard to them, is not limited to any Numbir of Days. A few Hours after the Great Dutchess's Delivery, two Valets de Chambre were dispatched as Couriers to Vienna and Madrid; and Yesterday Count Thurn, the Captain of the Guard, sat out for Vienna, Colonel Capponi for Madrid, Marquis Albizzi for Naples, and Count Montauti for Brussels, to acquant those Courts, in Form, of this Event.
