An Act to indemnify fuch Persons as have omitted to qualify themselves for Offices and Employments within the Time limited by Law, and for allowing further Time for that Purpose; and to indemnify Members and Officers in Cities, Corporations, and Borough Town, whose Admissions have been emitted to be Stamped according to Law or having been Stamped Stamped according to Law, or, having been Stamped, have been lost or missaid, and for allowing them Time to provide Admissions duly Stamped.

An AA for Repealing to much of an AE made in the Seventh and Eighth Years of the Reign of King William the Third, intituled, An AE to encourage the bringing Plate into the Mint to be coined, and for the futher remedying the ill State of the Coin of the Ringdom, as refinains any Perfon keeping an Inn, Tavan, Ale-bouse, or Victualling-bouse, or selling Wine, Ak, Beer, or any other Liquors, by retail, from publich using any appeals of manufactured Plate or hely using any acrought or manufactured Plate, or any Utenfil or Vessel thereof, except Spoons, and for

putting an End to Prosecutions commenced for Offences against Such Part of the Said Act.

An Act for the better Paving, Cleanfing, Lighting, and Watching, the Liberty of St. Martin le Grand, within the City and Liberty of Westminster, in the County of Middlesex; and for preventing Obstructions

and Annoyances therein.

An Act for continuing two Acts made in the Sixth Year of King George the First, and in the Seventh Year of his late Majesty, for laying a Duty of two Pennics Scots, or one fixth Part of a Penny Sterling, upon every Pint of Ale or Beer that shall be vended or sold within the Town of Montrose, and Privileges thereof for supplying the said Town swith fresh thereof, for supplying the said Town with fresh Water, and for other Purposes therein mentioned.

An Act for the better Paving, Cleanfing, Lighting, and Watching, the Streets and Lanes in the Parish and Borough of New Windfor, in the County of Berks, and for Preventing Nuisances and Annoyances therein.

An Act for repairing the Road from the Town of Denbigh to the Turnpike-Road between Northop and Holowiell and from Agion Wen'to the Town of Muld-

Holywell, and from Avon Wen'to the Town of Mold,

in the Counties of Denbigh and Flint.

An Ast for amending, widening, altering, clearing, and keeping in Repair, several Roads leading from the Borough of Dorchester in the County of Dorfet; and for repealing so much of an Act passed in the Sixth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, as relates to the Repairing the Road leading from Wool to the said Borough.

An Act to impower the Right Honourable Sir Henry Cavendish, Bart. to shut up certain Roads and a Foot-Path in the Parish of Doveridge in the County of Derby, and to oblige him to make, and keep in Repair for the future, a new Read and Foot-Path in lieu

thereof.

An Act to enlarge the Term and Powers of an Act, passed in the Sixteenth Year of King George the Second, for repairing the Reads from Marlborough to Shepherd's Shord, and from Beckhampton to the Top of Cherill Hill, and from Avebury to Beckhampton in of Cherill Hill, and from Avebury to Beckhampton in the County of Wilts; and for repairing and widening the Road from the Turnpike Gate at Avebury to Wroughton, and from the North Side of Swindon to the Carpenters Arms in Blunsden in the said County.

An Act for repairing and widening the Road leading from Mereworth Cross to the Road leading from Scal to Wrotham Heath; and also the said Road, from opposite the House of William Dalison, Esq; to Hadlow Street in the County of Kent.
