Whereas it has been humbly represented to the King, That betwixt Nine in the Evening of Tuesday the 18th, and Two in the Afternoon of Wednesday the 19th of July ult. a Desk in the Writing-Chamber of John Davidjon, Writer to the Signet, Castlehill, Edinburgh, was opened by some wicked Person or Persons unknown, by a counterfeit Key as is supposed (as the Desk was again locked) and sundry Bank Notes taken out thereof, to the Amount of Three Hundred and Sixty-seven Pounds Sterling; and amongst the Notes, there was one of the Old Bank, or Bank of Scotland, for One Hundred Pounds: His Majesty, for the better discovering and bringing to Justice the Person or Persons concerned in the above Crime, is hereby pleased to promise His most gracious Pardon to any one of the Offenders, (except the Person principally concerned) who shall discover his or her Accomplice or Accomplices in the said Crime, so as that he she, or they may be apprehended and convicted thereof.
