

WHEREAS an anonymous Letter hath been received by the Right Honorable the Lord Mayor, and by him transmitted to the Earl of Suffolk, representing, that the Writer thereof would make some important Discoveries concerning the late Fire at Portsmouth Dock, if he were assured of His Majesty's Pardon; which Letter hath been humbly laid before the King: His Majesty is hereby pleased to promise His most gracious Pardon to the Writer of the said Letter for the Offences therein mentioned, provided Information shall be given to one of the Principal Secretaries of State, upon which the Parties concerned may be apprehended and brought to Justice.

St. James's, August 2.

This Day the Marquis de Carraccioli, Envoy Extraordinary from the King of the Two Sicilies, had an Audience of Leave of His Majesty.

And afterwards the Count de Pignatelli, his Successor in the same Character, had a Private Audience of His Majesty, to deliver his Credentials.

To which they were introduced by the Right Honourable the Earl of Rochford, one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State; and conducted by Stephen Cottrell, Esq; Assistant Master of the Ceremonies.

Whereas it has been humbly represented to the King, that the following threatening Letter was found in the Back-Yard of the House of Peter Delande, in Sudbury in the County of Suffolk, Gentleman, on the 2d Day of July last, directed as follows, viz.

Sir.

Notwithstanding your Conduct for some Years have bin such as have merited the ill Will of some hundreds of the Freemen of this Borough, yet not with standing Humanity teacheth me to cation you against the direersfull Effects that will fall on your Heads from the bitter Resentment such Freemen have or may firstain from your devilish and hellish Proceedings, which will be no less then certainly to take away your Lives by a premeditated Skem which will surely be effected by a small though despret Set of Min, who have bound themselves upon Oth to accomplish the same before you are aware of, and that not to you a lone but some others, who deserve and will surely shire the same Fate, but will have no Cation unless you please to communicate it your self, pray pardin me for being so free for this; I surely know that you will have your just Defents by one External Blow. This from as good a Freeman as any Black amongst you, which as nathan said to David thou art the Man.

His Majesty, for the better discovering and bringing to Justice the Persons concerned in writing and Dressing the said Letter, does hereby promise His most gracious Pardon to any one of them (except the Person who actually wrote the said Letter) who shall discover his, her, or their Accomplice or Accomplices therein, so that he, she, or they may be apprehended and convicted thereof.

POUNDS to the Person making such Discovery; to be paid upon the Conviction of any one or more of the said Offenders.
