Vienna, September 15.

ON Monday Morning, the 13th Instant, his Imperial Majesty arrived at Schonbrunn in perfect Health.

Berlin, September 18. On Tuesday last, the 14th Instant, in the Evening, his Prussian Majesty arrived at Charlottenburg, and the following Day reviewed the Artillery in the Neighbourhood of this Town, and returned the same Day to Dinner at Potsdam.

St. James's, September 21, 1773.

Whereas it has been humbly represented to the King, That on Friday the 17th Instant, about Eleven o'Clock at Night, a Fire broke out in one of the Barns of John Smart, of Gillingham Grange in the Parish of Gillingham in the County of Kent, which in a short Time consumed the same, together with another Barn almost contiguous, with a considerable Quantity of Corn in each, to the amount of about Three Hundred Quarters of Wheat and about Two Hundred Quarters of Barley; and that there is the strongest Reason to suspect that the same was wilfully and maliciously set on Fire: His Majesty, for the better discovering and bringing to Justice the Persons concerned in so heinous a Crime, is hereby pleased to promise His most gracious Pardon to any one of them, (except the Person who actually set Fire to the same) who shall discover his or her Accomplice or Accomplices therein, so that he, she, or they, may be apprehended and convicted thereof.
