Florence, April 16 . The Great Duke and Dutchefs have retired to a Villa near the Town, where four of the young Princes and Princeffes were inoculated two Days ago by Dr. Gatti. Their Royal Highneffes admit nobody to approach them at the Villa; but the Great Dukc returgs frequently on Foot to the Palace in Town, to receive his Minifters. An Efaffette was fent to Vienna a few Hours after the Inoculation was performed.
