Dublin Castle, June 2. 1774. HIS Day his Excellency the Lord Lieutenant went in State to the House of Peers; and being feated on the Throne with the usual Ceremony, his Excellency fent for the Commons, and gav the Royal Affere to the following Bills:

en Ast for granting to His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, the yearly Sums therein mentioned; and for the better Support of the Foundling Hospital and Workbouse of the City of Dublin, and for increasing the Fund

An Ast for the better regulating the Office of County Treaturer, and the Duty of Clerks of the Crown in refer to I resentments; and to enable the grand Jury of he County of Wicklow to raise Money by Present-ments, for purchasing of Ground or Houses adjoining to the Court House of the said County, for the Purpose of building Additions to the said Court-House.

An All for the better and more certain Valuation of Houses in Counties of Cities and Counties of Towns.

A. A. for amending the Laws relative to the lighting and cleanfing of several Cities, and for establishing of Market Juries therein, and for other Purposes.

An Act for amending an Act passed in the third Year

of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, An All for the bet-ter Regulation of the Linen and Hempen Manufactures.

An Ast for Pawing the Streets, Lanes, Quays, Bridges, Squares, Courts, and Alleys within the City and County of the City of Dublin, and other Purposes relative to the said City of Dublin, and other Places therein particularly mentioned.

An Ast for enforcing a due Execution of the Laws relative to Turnpike Roads in this Kingdom.

An All to amend an All possed in the sighth Year of His present Mojest, intituled An all for creding new Chapels of Ease in the Parsh of Armagh, and making such Chapels, and those that are already eredled in said Parish, perpetual Cures; and for making a proper Prowision for the Mointenance of persecual Curates to officiate in the same, and for other Purposes.

An Ast for amending and continuing an Ast passed in the third Year of His present Euriety, intituled, An Ast for the more essential amending and rep i ing the Road leading from the City of Dublin to the Bridge of Dunleer, and for the letter fecuring the Debti- due, or to

grow due, to the Creditors of faid Road.

An Att for amending and repairing the Road leading from the City of Cork to the Brook which bounds the Counties of Cork to the Bind winds out of Kil-worth Mountain, and from thence to the Road leading from the Town of Clonnell in the County of Tipperary, through the Towns of Clopneen, Mitchell's Town, and to Doneraile in the County of Cork, and for making ad-ditional Traffees for the Turnpike Road between Kilkenny and Callan.

An Act for amending the Road from Dundalk to Dun-

leer in the County of Louth.

An Ast for explaining and amending an Ast passed in the Fifth Year of His prosent Majesty's Reign, intituled, An Act for erecting and establishing Public Infirmaries or Hospitals in this Kingdom.

An Act to amend an Act passed the last Session of Parliament, intituted, An Act for the Relief of the Inscipent Debtors named in the annexed Schedules.
