Vienna, August 3.

THIS Day at Noon a Courier arrived here with the News of Peace between Russia and the Porte having been concluded on the 17th of July, at the Head Quarters at Buyak Canarochi, and signed, on the Part of their respective Sovereigns, by Marshal Count Romanzow, and Achmed Effendi, Chiaga to the Grand Vizir.

Brussels, August 12. On Wednesday last died, at his Country House, most sincerely regretted by the Court, and all that knew him, the Marquis d'Ynse, Knight of the Golden Fleece, Lord of the Bed-Chamber, Lieutenant-General, Colonel of a Regiment of Infantry, and Captain of the Guard Noble.

St. James's, August 16.

The King has been pleased, on the humble Petition of the Merchants, Tradersmen, and Freeholders of the Borough of Helleston in the County of Cornwall, to re-incorporate the same by the Name of the Mayor and Commonalty of the Borough of Helleston, and to grant and confirm to them, and their Successors, their antient Powers, Authorities, Liberties, and Privileges.
