The Prince Adolplus of Derxpont, hath by Lecter to the States of he Emipire affembled here, prayed their good offices in be half of himfelf, and the Duke of Deuxponts, as there may be ocoafi $n$. The States of the Circle of Franconia make great Complaints of the oppreftions they lie under, by being oblized to furnifh Winter quarters to the Inperial Irocps, to the ruine of their Countries.

Strasburgh; Decemb. 4 . The EleEtoral Prince of Saxony continues fill here, being fumewhat indifpofed. All the plates in Alja6e are crowded with Coldiers 3 fo ishat the poor people in many places forfake their houres fand tabiations, for that there is no room for them.
