Chelsea Hospital, February 20, 1775.

THESSE are, by Order of the Right Honorable the Lords and others the Commissioners for Managing the Affairs of the Royal Hospital at Chelsea, give Notice, That His Majesty has given Directions that all Out-Pensioners belonging to the said Hospital, residing in London or within Twenty five Miles thereof, do appear personally at the Secretary's Office within the said Hospital; such Pensioners therefore, as live in London or within Twenty five Miles thereof, are required to appear personally at the said Office, and are required also to appear Regimentally on the respective Days appointed for them, when Attendance will be given from Nine o'Clock in the Morning till Three in the Afternoon, in order to their being examined by a Board appointed for that Purpose, viz.

Monday, March 6.

The Pensioners from the 1st Troop, 2d and late 3d and 4th Troops of Horse Guards; 1st and 2d Troops of Horse Grenadier Guards; Royal Horse Guards Blue; 3d, 4th, and late 7th Regiments of Horse; Lettlemen and Men at 9 d. per Day.

The Pensioners from the 1st, 2d, and 3d Regiments of Dragoon Guards, and all the Dragoons.

BARRINGTON.

Constantinople, January 4. The Christians in the Crimea are fled to the Russians, and the Empréss has given Orders to build a large Town for their Reception, between Kerch and Janicale. Duclett Gherci, with the Turkish Troops, is still at Caffa; and there are five thousand Russian Troops within the Peninsula, and two thousand without, waiting to take Possession of Kinburn Brigadier Boronzoff is to sail for Paros the latter End of next Week, having compleated his Purchase of Bread and Flour for the Fleet.

Constantinople, January 4. The Hospodar of Wallachia is set out for his Principality; but the Ambassador of the Port to the Court of Petersburg has not yet begun his Journey for that City; and Marshal Romanzow is still in Moldavia.

Florence, January 31. A few Days ago Rear Admiral Bafbal arrived at Porto Ferrajo with Three Russian Ships of the Line, which are to be repaired in that Port.
