A PROCLAMATION,

Appointing the Difiribution of Prizes taken during the Continuance of the Rebellion now fulfifting in divers Parts of the Continent of North America.

GEORGE R. HEREAS by an A&, made in this pre-fent Seffion of Parliament, intituled, "An "A& to prohibit all Trade and Inter-" courfe with the Colonies of New Hamp-" fhire, Maffachufet's Bay, Rhode Ifland, Connecticut, " New York, New Jerfey, Penfylvania, the Three Lower Counties on Delaware, Maryland, Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Georgia, during the Continuance of the prefent Rebellion within the faid Colonies respectively; for repealing an Act, made in the Fourteenth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majefty, to difcontinue the Landing and Dif-charging, Lading or Shipping, of Goods, Wares, ~ and Merchandize, at the Town and within the Harbour of Bolton, in the Province of Maffachufet's Bay; and alfo Two Acts, made in the last Session of " Parliament, for reftraining the Trade and Commerce of the Colonies in the faid Acts respectively men-" ** " tioned; and to enable any Perfon or Perfons, ap-" toned; and to chable any Perion or Perions, ap-" pointed and authorized by His Majefty, to grant Par-" dons, to iffue Proclamations, in the Cafes and for " the Purpoles therein mentioned;" it is, amongh other Things, enacted, That all Ships and Veffels of or belonging to the Inhabitants of the faid Colonies, toge-ther with their Cargoes, Apparel, and Furniture? except or in the faid Adverse control and Furniture? ther with their Cargoes, Apparer, and Furniture, except as in the faid Act are excepted, and all other Ships and Veffels whatfoever, together with their Cargoes, Appa-rel, and Furniture, which fhall be found trading in any Port or Place of the faid Colonies, or going to trade, or coming from Trading, in any fuch Port or Place, except as are therein allo excepted, shall become forfeited to the Meinfer as if the forme were the Shins and Efexcept as are therein allo excepted, mail become formence to Ilis Majefty, as if the fame were the Ships and Ef-fects of Open Enemics, and thall be fo adjudged, deemed, and taken, in all Courts of Admiralty, and in all other Courts whatfoever: And, for the Encourage-ment of the Officers and Seatnen of His Majefty's Ships of War, it is thereby alfo further enacted. That the of War, it is thereby allo further enacted. That the Flag Officers, Captains, Commanders, and other com-miflioned Officers in His Majefty's Pay, and alfo the Seamen, Marines, and Soldiers on Board, fhall have the fole Intercft and Property of and in all and every fuch Ship, Veffel, Goods, and Merchandize, which they fhall feize and take, (heing first adjudged lawful Prize in any of His Majefty's Courts of Admiralty) to be divided in fuch Proportions. and after fuch Manuer. be divided in fuch Proportions, and after fuch Manner, as His Majefty shall think fit to order and direct by Proclamation or Proclamations hereafter to be iffued for clamation or Proclamations hereafter to be iffued for those Purposes: We, taking the Premises into Confider-ation, do, purfuant to the faid Act of Parliament, (with the Advice of Our Privy Council) by this Our Procla-mation, order, direct, and appoint, That the next Pro-duce of all Prizes taken, in Purfuance of the faid Act, by Our Ships of War, be divided into Eight equal Parts, and be distributed in Manner following, that is to five. To the Captain or Captains of Auv of Our Ships to fuy, To the Captain or Captains of any of Our Ships of Mar, who shall be actually on Board at the Taking of any Prize, Three Eighth Parts; but in cafe any fuch Prize shall be taken by any of Our Ship or Ships of War, under the Command of a Flag or Flags, the Flag Officer or Officers being actually on Board, or directing and officing in the fCapture, shall have One of the faid

Three Eighth Parts, the faid One Eighth Part to be paid to fuch Flag or Flag Officers, in such Proportions, and subject to such Regulations, as are herein-after for that Purpole mentioned : To the Captains of Marines and Land Forces, Sea Lieutenants and Master, on Board any fuch Ships, One Eighth Part, to be equally divided amongit them : To the Lieutenants and Quarter-Mafters amongit them: To the Lieutenants and Quarter-Mafters of Marines, and Lieutenants, Enfigns, and Quarter-Mafters of Land Forces, Boatfwain, Guinier, Purier, Carpenter, Mafter's Mate, Chirurgeon, Pilot, and Chaplain, on Board any fuch Ship, One Eighth Part, to be equally divided amongft them: To the Midfhip-men, Secretary to Flag Officers, Captain's Clerk, Ma-fter Sail Maker, Carpenter's Mates, Boatfwain's Mates, Gunner's Mates, Mafter at Arms, Corporale, Yeomen of the Sheets, Coxtwain, Quarter Mafters, Quarter Mafter's Mates, Chirurgeon's Mates, Yeomen of the Powder Room, and Serjeants of Marines or Land Forces, on Beard any fuch Ships, One Eighth Part, to be equally divided amongit them: To the Trumpeters, be equally divided amongit them : To the Trumpeters, Quarter-Gunners, Carpenter's Crew, Steward, Cook, Almouler, Steward's Mate, Cook's Mate, Gunfmith, Cooper, Swabber, Ordinary Trumpeter, Barber, Abla Scanen, Ordinary Seamen, and Marine or other Sol-diers, and all other Perfons doing Duty or affifting on Board any fuch Ships, Two Eighth Parts, to be equally divided amongst them. And in cale any Sea Captain, inferior Commiffion or Warrant Sea Officers belonging to any Ship of War, for whom any Shares of Prizes are hereby allowed, be absent at the Time of the Capture of any Prize, the Share of fuch Sea Captain, inferior of any Prize, the Share of Juch Sea Captain, interior Commillion or Warrant Sea Officer, thall be caft into the Shares hereby allowed to the Trumpeters, Quarter Gunners, Carpenter's Crew, Steward, Cook, Armourer, Steward's Mate, Cook's Mate, Gunfinith, Cooper, Swabber, Ordinary Trumpeter, Barber, Able Seamen, Ordinary Seamen, and Marine or other Soldiers, and other Perfons doing Duty or affifting on Board any fuch Ships, to be equally divided amongit them. Provided, That if Other or Officers on Board any of Our Ships of War, at the Time of taking any fich Prizes, fhail have more Commiffions or Offices than one, he or they fhall be intitled only to the Share or Shares of the faid Prizes, which, according to the above-mentioned Distribution, thall belong to his or their respective superior Commis-sions or Offices. And We do hereby strictly enjoin all and every Commander and Commanders of any Ships of War, taking any Prize, as foon as may be, to tranimit, or caule to be transmitted, to the Commissioners of Our Navy, a true Lift of the Names of all the Officers, Our Navy, a true Lut of the Names of all the Omcers, Seamen, Marines, Soldiers, or others, who were actu-ally on Board Our Ships of War, under his or their Command, at the taking fuch Prize; which Lift fhall contain the Quality of the Service of each Performant Board, and be fublicitied by the Captain or Command-ing Others and There are more the Other Onit of Omer ing Officer, and Three or more of the Chief Officer , ou Board. And We do hereby require and direct the Commiffioners of Our Navy, or any Three or more of them, to examine, or caufe to be examined, fuch Lifts by the Mufter-Books of fuelt Ships of War, and Lifts an-nexed thereto, to fee that fuch Lifts do agree with the faid Mufter-Book, and annexed Lifts, as to the Names, Qualities, or Ratings of the Officers, Seamen, Marinies, Soldiers, and others belonging to fuch Ship of War; and, upon Request, forthwith to grant a Certificate of the Truth of any Lift transmitted to them, to the Agents' nominated and appointed by the Ciptors, purfuant to the fail Act, to take Care or dilp fe of such Prize'; and
