An AEt to prevent Frauds in obtaining the Premiums for Flax Seed imported into this Kingdom.

An Att for allowing further Time to Perfons in Offices or Employments to qualify themselves, purfuant to an AA intituled An AA to prevent the further Growth of Popery.

An Act to explain and amend an Act paffed last Seffions of Parliament, intituled An Act for amending the Road from Dundalk to Dunker in the County of Lowth.
