 HE following Addrefs of the Gentlemen, Clergy, Freemen, Fueeholders, Merchants, Traders; Manufagturers, and other Citizens of Dublin, having been tranfimitted to the Right Honourable Lord Vifcount Weymouth, One of His Majefty's Principal Secretarics of State, has been prefented to His Majefty : Which Addrefs His Majelty was plealed to receive very gracioufly.To the KING's moft Excellent Majelty,
The humble Addrefs of the Gintlemen, Clergy, Freemen, Freeholders, Merchants, Traders, Manufacturers, and other Citizens of Dublin.
May it pleafe your Majeßb,

W, the Gentlemen, Clergy, Freènen, Freeholders, Merchgnts, Traders, Manufacturers, and other Citizens of Dublin, the Metropolis of your. Majefty's Kingdom of Ireland,-feeling ourfelves at this Time particularly called upon, embrace with Pleafure the Opportunity of teltifying to your Majelty our iteadfalt Loyalty, and zealous Attachment to your Sacred Perfun, Crown, and Dignity; for the Prefervation and Honour of which, we are and ever fhall be ready to devote our Lives and Fortunes; truly fenible of the Happiners we enjoy under your Majefty's mild and aufpious Government.

We hear, with equal Sorrow and Aftonifurent, that many of your mifguided Subjects in America have withdrawn themfelves from their Allegiance to your Najelty. We fament that, influenced by the Ccunicls of wicked and defigning Men, they have even dared to adopt a Syftem tending to render themfelves independent of the Parent Country; yet, deeply affected by the Troubles fublifing in the Colonies: we have the fulitet Reliance on your Majefty's Wifdom and Juftice, that you will purfue with Firmnefs fuch Meafures as may tend effectually to reftore the violated Rigits of the Britinh Empire.

We feel ourfelves bound, at fo important and critical a Coijuncture, molt humbly and zealoully to lay our Hearts at the Foot of the Throne, and to exprefs our warmeft Gratitude for your Majeity's patemal Goodnefs to this your Kingdom of Ireland, fo recently and fo amply hewn by feveral Acts of the Britifh Parliament for the Encouragement of our Commerce, Manu. factures, and Agriculture: And our. Duty alfo leads us to acknowledge the grateful Senfe we en:ertain of your Majefty's peculiar Indulgence, in fending to prefide over us fo excellent; a Chief Governor ; to whofe faithful Reprefentation of our Loyalty and Attachment we attribute thefe important Advantages, which have flowed to us from your Royal Protection and Favour.

Alarmed with Apprehenfions from what we have heard, and grateful for the Bleffing; we feel and enjoy; we cannot avoid fervently to offer our Prayers to the Almighty, for the Prefervation of your Majelty's Royal pafon and Family; that your Reign oyer us may be long and happy, and that you may ever triumph over the Enemies of our glorious Conltitution.
