Clemency would have due Influence upon their future Behaviour : His Majefty is pleased to grant His Free Pardon to all Deferters from His Land Forces who shall furrender themselves, before the 1 oth Day of April next, either to the Regiments to which they belong, or to fome other Corps in His Majesty's Service, or to any Additional Company or Recruiting Party in Great Britain or Ireland

Such Deferters, if ablebodied Men and fit for Service, shall be attested in the Corps to which they furrender, and not be liable to be claimed by any other Corps to which they may formerly have belonged.

And whereas many of the faid Deferters may have inlifted in other Corps, and are now ferving therein; His Majesty is graciously pleased to extend to such Deferters the Benefit of this Pardon, and to direct, That they shall continue to ferve in the Corps wherein they now are, and not be claimed by that in which they formerly ferved

And whereas feveral of the faid Deferters have been apprehended, and are now in Gaol or in Re-gimental Cuftody: His Majefty is likewife pleafed to grant to them His Free Pardon, of which they are to have the Benefit, upon their Arrival at their respective Regiments, or upon their being inlisted by fome other Corps, or Recruiting Party.

Any Soldier who may defert, after these His Majeky's most gracious Intentions are made Public, shall not be included in the above Pardon, but be proceeded againft with the utmoft Severity. By His Majeity's Command,
