HE following Address of the Provoft, Magistrates and Common-Council of the Royal Burgh of Wick, in Council affembled, has been prefented to His Majerty by John Sinclair, Efq; being introduced by the Lord of His Majefty's Bed-Chamber in Waiting : Which Addrefs His Majefty was pleafed to receive very gracioufly : And Mr. Sinclair had the Honour to kifs His Majefty's Hand.

Unto the KING's most Excellent Majesty,

The humble Address of the Provost, Magistrates and Common-Council of the Royal Burgh of Wick, in Council affembled.

Moft Gracious Sovereign, WE, your Majefty's moft dutiful and loyal Subjects, the Provoft, Magistrates and Com-W Subjects, the Provoft, Magistrates and Com-mon-Council of the Royal Burgh of Wick, for ourfelves, and in Behalf of the other Inhabitants of this Burgh, beg Leave most humbly to approach your Majesty with the genuine Sentiments of Hearts full of Loyalty and Affection to the best of Kings, and flowing with Gratitude for the invaluable Blef. fings and Privileges which we enjoy under a mild and constitutional Government.

We should be wanting in Duty to your Majefty, to your Parliament, and to our Country, did we not declare to the World our hearty Difapprobation and Abhorrence of the rebellious Conduct of our Fellow Subjects in America, and of the feditious Spirit of a discontented Faction at Home, whom we confider as the worft Enemies of their Country, and the corrupted Fountain whence the prefent Evils -We always underflood that the Afta have fprung .of the Supreme Legislature of this Kingdom should extend with equal Force to every Part of your Ma-jesty's extensive Dominions : We must therefore confider every Attempt to oppose that Power as re-pugnant to the British Constitution. And when we reflect with what daring Infolence and Contempt the Authority of the Laws has been repeatedly fet at Defiance by the Americans, we can no longer withhold our unanimous Affent to the vigorous Exertion of fuch Measures as will force these deluded People to fubmit to a Conflicational Dependence upon your Majesty's Government. And at fame Time we do affure your Majefty, that, with our Lives and Fortunes, we are ready to contribute to the due Execution of fuch neceffary and indifpenfible Meafures
