On the 18th an Austrian Corps obliged General So-beck to evacuate Leitmeritz, and pass the Elbe near Lowitz. Prince Henry was on the 19th still at Tschikowitz; and had ordered General Moellen-dorff with his Corps to advance towards Liboschko-witz; and Major Goltz, with some Squadrons of Hussars, towards the Circle of the Mountains.

A PROCLAMATION,

For granting the Distribution of Prizes during the present Hostilities.

G E O R G E R.

WHEREAS, by Our Order in Council dated the Twenty-ninth Day of July last, We have ordered, That general Reprisals be granted against the Ships, Goods and Subjects of the French King; and that as well Our Fleets and Ships, as also all other Ships and Vessels that shall be commissioned by Letters of Marque or general Reprisals, or otherwise, by Our Commissioners for executing Our Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, shall and may lawfully seize all Ships, Vessels and Goods belonging to the French King, and bring the same to Judgement in any of Our Courts of Admiralty within Our Dominions: We, being desirous to give due Encouragement to all Our faithful Subjects who shall lawfully seize the same; and having declared in Council, by Our Order of the Seventh of last Month, Our Intentions concerning the Distribution of all Manner of Captures, Seizures, Prizes and Reprisals, of all Ships and Goods, during the present Hostilities, do now make known to all Our loving Subjects, and all others whom it may concern, by this Our Proclamation, by and with the Advice of Our Privy Council, that Our Will and Pleasure is, That the Neat Produce of all Prizes taken, the Right whereof is inherent in Us and Our Crown, be given to the Takers,
