Rullia or Poland, until His Majesty's Pleasure fhould be further fignified : And whereas it hath been reprefented to His Majesty at this Board, , that the most exact Enquiry hath been made, and that it doth not appear that there hath been any Contagious Distemper amongst the Horned Cattle in any of the Provinces of Poland: His Majesty taking the fame into Confideration, and being defirous to remove all Obstructions on Trade, as far as is confident with the Security of this Kingdom against fuch a Calamity, is pleased, with the Advice of His Privy Council, to order, as it is hereby ordered, that the faid Prohibition be taken off, fo far as respects the Importation of the above mentioned Articles from any Ports or Places within the Dominions of Poland.-And the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of His Majefly's Treafury, and the Lord Lieutenant of His Majesty's Kingdom of Ireland, are to give the necessary Directions herein, as to them may refpectively appertain.
