PRESENT, The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

HEREAS the Time limited by His Ma-jesty's Order in Connection jesty's Order in Council of the 17th of February last, for prohibiting the Exporting out of this Kingdom, or carrying Coastwife, Gunpowder, Saltpetre, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition, will expire on the 23d of this instant May: And whereas it is judged expedient that the faid Pro-hibition should be continued for some Time longer, except in those Cases where (for the Benefit and Advantage of Trade, and for the Use and Defence of Ships trading to Foreign Parts, and of the Transports and Victualling Vessels employed in His Majesty's Service) His Majesty, by His several Orders in Council of the 13th and 27th of October, and of the 6th and 22d of November, 1775, of the 5th and 19th of February, and the 23d of August and 25th of September, 1776, of the 16th of April, the 13th of August, and the 3d and 10th of October, 1777, of the 19th of June, the 7th and 26th August, and the 10th of September last, has thought proper to permit and allow the Exportation of, and carrying Coastwife, Gunpowder, Saltpetre, Arms and Ammunition, undercertain Conditions and Restrictions mentioned in the faid Orders! His Majelly doth therefore, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, hereby order, require, prohibit, and command, that no Person or Persons whosoever (except the Master-General, Lieutenant-General, or Principal Officers of the Ordnance, for His Majelly's Service) do, at any Time during the Space of Three Months, to commence from the said 23d Day of this inflant May, presume to transport into any Parts out of this Kingdom, or carry Coast-wife, any Gunpowder, Saltpetre, or any Sort of Arms of Ammunition, or ship or lade any Gunpowder, Saltpetre, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition, on Board any Ship or Vessel, in order to transporting the same beyond the Seas, or carrying the same Coastwise, except in the Cases comprized within the aforementioned Orders in Council, without Leave or Permission in that
