An All for the Advancement of Trade, and for granting to His Majefty, His Heirs and Succeffors, the Jeveral Duties therein mentioned.

An AC for continuing and amending feveral Laws relating to His Majefly's Revenue, and for the more effectually preventing of Frauds therein, and for fuch other Purpofes as are therein mentioned.

An Ast for explaining and amending an Ast paffed in the Fifteenth and Sixteenth Years of the Reign of George the Third, intitled, an Act for the better regu-lating the Pipe Water of the City of Dublin.

An A& for reviewing, continuing and amending feveral temporary Statutes

An Act for the Relief of Perfons who have omitted to qualify themselves according to Law.

An AEt to amend and continue an AEt paffed in the Seventeenth and Eighteenth Years of the Reign of His present Majesty, intitled, an Act to amend and continue an AEI paffed in the Thirteenth and Fourteenth Years of His prefent Majefty, intitled, an Att for the better re-gulating of the Baking Trade in the City of Dublin, and for other Purpofes.

An AE to amend a Mistake in an AE passed in the Thirteenth and Fourteenth Years of His prefent Majefly, intitled, an AEI for amending the Public Roads. An AEI to improver Grand Juries to contract for

An AB for altering, amending, and continuing, and making more effectual, an ACT make in the Thirteenth and Fourteenth Years of the Reign of His prefent Majefty, intitled, an Act for amending and repairing the Road leading from the City of Cork to the Brook which bounds the Counties of Cork and Tipperary, near the Foot of Kilworth Mountain, and on to Knockboy Turnpike Gate, and for other Purposes.

An Act for amending an Act made in the Thirteenth Year of His late Majefly George the Second, initialed, an Act for repairing and amending the Road leading from the Town of Clonmill in the County of Tipperary, through the Towns of Clogbeen, Mitchelftown, and to Doneraile in the County of Cork; and an other A& paffed in the Townsy-ninth Year of His Said late Ma-jefty's Reign, intilled, an A& for amending and re-pairing the Jaid Road, and for other Purpofes.

An Act for making and keeping in Repair, a Road to lead from the Town of Nenagh in the County of Tipperary, to O'Briens Bridge in the County of Clare

An Act for the better Regulation of the Silk Manufacture.

An AE to amend an AE, intitled, an AE for making and amending public Roads in the County of Dublin, and for regulating, applotting, and lewying of Money in the County of the City of Dublin.

An AEI for further enforcing a due Execution of the Laws relative to Turnpike Roads in this Kingdom.

An AEI for making and repairing, and foortening, a Road from the Crofs of Callan in the County of Kilkenny, through the Town of Mullinahone, and by the Ford of Kilmore, called Black Ford and Poorflown in the Town of Clonmell in the County of Tipperary.

An A& for regulating the curing and preparing Provisions, and for preventing Combinations among the feveral Tradefmen and other Perfons employed in making up fuch Provisions, and for regulating the Butter Trade in the City of Dublin, and for other Purpofes therein mentioned.
