The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council. THEREAS His Majefty was gracioufly pleafed, by His Royal Proclamation, bearing Date the 25th Day of October, 1776, to promife and declare, That the Bounties of Five Pounds for every Able Sea man, and of Two Pounds Ten Shillings for every Ordinary Seaman, fit for His Majesty's Service, should be paid in the Manner thereby directed, to every fuch Able and Ordinary Seaman, not above the Age of Fifty, nor under the Age of Eighteen Years, who should, on or before the 31st of December then follow-ing, enter themselves to serve in His Majesty's Royal Navy, either with the Captains or Lieutenants of His Majesty's Ships, or the Chief Officers on Board fuch Tenders as should be employed for raising Men for the Service of the Royal Navy: And whereas His Majesty was also pleased, by His Royal Proclamation, bearing Date the 8th Day of November, 1776, to promife and declare, That a Re-ward of Two Pounds for every Able, and Thirty Shillings for every Ordinary Seaman, fhould be paid in the Manner thereby directed, to any Perfon who should discover any Seaman or Seamen who might fecrete themselves, that so such Seaman or Seamen should be taken for His Majesty's said Service, by any of His Majesty's Sea-Officers employed for raising Men, on or before the 31st Day of De-cember, 1776: And whereas His Majesty was like-wife pleased, by His Royal Proclamation, bearing Whe pleated, by His Royal Proclamation, bearing Date the 15th Day of August, 1777, to promise and declare, That every Able-bodied Landman, not above the Age of Thirty-five, nor under the Age of Twenty Years, who should voluntarily enter him-felf to ferve on Board any of His Majesty's Ships, on or before the 31st Day of October then next, should receive, as of His Majesty's Royal Bounty, the Sum of Thirty Shiping on the prod the Sum of Thirty Shillings each Man, to be paid in Manner thereby directed : And whereas the Time limited by the faid Proclamations, for Pay-ment of the faid Bounties and Rewards, hath been prolonged and extended to the 30th Day of this instant September; and it being judged expedient for His Majelty's Service that the faid Bounties and Rewards should be continued to be paid for some Time longer, His Majesty, with the Advice of His Privy-Council, doth therefore order, and it is hereby accordingly ordered, that the Time limited for Payment of the faid Bounties and Rewards be prolonged and extended from the faid 30th Day of this in-take Notice, and govern themfelves accordingly.
