AT the Court at St. James's, the 15th of November, 1780,

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council, Hereas the Time limited by His Majefty's Order in Council of the 18th of August laft, for prohibiting the Exporting out of this King-dom, or carrying Coastwife, Gunpowder, Saltpetre, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition, will expire on the 23d of this inftant November : And whereas it is judged expedient that the faid Prohibition should be continued for some Time longer, except in those Cases where (for the Be-nesit and Advantage of Trade, and for the Use and Défence of Ships trading to Foreigh Parts, and of the Transports and Victualling Vessels employed in His Majesty's Service) His Majesty, by His feveral Orders in Council of the 13th and 27th of October, and of the 6th and 22d of November, 1775, of the 5th and 19th of February, and the 23d of August and 25th of September, 1776, of the 16th of April, the 13th of August, and the 3d and 10th of October, 1777, of the 19th of June, the 7th and 26th of August, and the 10th of September, 1778, and of the 17th of May last, has thought proper to permit and allow the Exportation of, and carrying Coaftwife, Gunpow-der, Saltpetre, Arms and Ammunition, under certain Conditions and Refrictions mentioned in the faid Orders : His Majefly doth therefore, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, hereby order, require, prohibit, and command, that no Perfon or Perfons whofoever (except the Mafter-General, Lieutenant-General, or Principal Officers of the Ordnance, for His Majefty's Service) do, at any Time during the Space of Three Months, to commence from the faid 23d of Day this Instant November, prefume to transport into any Parts out of this Kingdom, or carry Coastwise, any Gunpowder, Saltpetre, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition, or thip or lade any Gunpowder, Saltpetre, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition;
