N Wednesday the 26th ult. Fair Island bearing N. W. diftant 10 Leagues, I fell in with the Rouen Soubife, a Ship belonging to the French King, commanded by Pierre Vanltabel, a Lieutenant De Fregate, mounting 22 Nine Pounders, 156 Men, which we took, after chacing 13 Hours; and she is now in this Road.
