Hereas by an Act of Parliament passed in the last Session of Parliament, in-tituled, "An Act to impower His Ma-

" jefty to prohibit the Exportation, " and to reftrain the carrying Coaffwife, of Copper " in Bars or Copper in Sheets, for a limited Time," His Majefty is impowered, by Proclamation or Order in Council, when he fhall fee Caufe, and for fuch Time as fhall be therein expressed, to prohibit the Exporting, or attempting to Export, out of this Kingdom, or carrying Coaftwife in this Kingdom, any Sort of Copper in Sheets, or Cop-per in Bars, therein to be defcribed, in fuch Manner and under fuch Reftraints, as His Majefty shall think fit; and His Majesty judging it necessary for the Publick Good, at this Critical Conjuncture, to prohibit the Exporting of Copper out of this King-dom, or carrying Coaftwife the fame ; His Majelty doth therefore, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, hereby order, require, prohibit, and com-mand, That no Perfon or Perfons whofoever (ex-cept the Commissioners of His Majefty's Navy, or their Officers or Agents, for His Majetty's Service) do, at any Time during the Space of Three Months from the Date hereof, prelume to transport into any Parts out of this Kingdom, or carry Coaftwite in this Kingdom any Sort of Copper in Sheets or Copper in Bars, or fhip or lade any Copper in Sheets or Copper in Bars, on Board any Ship or Veffel, in order to tranfporting the fame beyond the Seas, or carrying the fame Coaffwile, without Leave or Permiffion in that Behalf first obtained from His Majesty or His Privy Council, upon Pain of incurring and fuffering the respective Forfeitures and Penalties inflicted by the Act of Parliament herein before recited.-And the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of His Majefty's Treasury, the Commissioners of this Majefty's Treasury, the Commissioners for exe-cuting the Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, the Lord Warden of the Cinque Ports, the Master-General of the Ordnance, and His Majefty's Secretary at War, are to give the neceffary Directions herein as to them may refpectively appertain.
