## Wefiminfter, May 17.

THIS Day, the Lords being met, a Merfage was fent to the Honourable Houle of Commons by Sir Francis Molyneux, Genteman Uher of the Black Rod, accuinting them, that The Lords, autborized by $V_{i \text { tī̀ue of }}{ }^{\prime}$ His Majefy's Commifion, for declaring His Ropai Afint to feveral Acts agreed upon by botb Houfes, do defire she immediate Attendance of this Hososerable Houfe in the Houfe of Peers, to bear the Commiffion read; and the Commons being come thither, the faid Commifion, impowering the Lord Archbifhop of Canterbury, the Lord High Chancellor of GreatBritain, the Lord Prefident of the Council, and feveral other Lords therein mentioned, to declare and notify the Royal Affent to the faid Acts, was read accordingly; and the Royal Affent given to

An AG for granting an addinional Du'y ufon Tobacco and Suuff; and for refealing rertain Duties payable upon the Imprrtation of Brandy and Arrack, and for granting other Duties in Lieu thereff.

An Aia for the previnting of Bribery and Corruption in the Elecition of Mmbers to ferve in Parliament for the Borough of Cricklade, in the County of Wilts.

An Aat for allowing the Importation of Goods, of the Growth, Produce, or Manufaciure of the Iflands of Saint Cbrifopher, Nevis, and Montferrat, into any; Ports of His Majefy's Dominions in Europe or Anerica, zpon Payment of the Britibl Plastation Duties.

An AIA for furtber continuing an ACI made in the Trwentieth Ytar of the Reign of His prefent Majefy, intituled, An Aci for exempting the Ciiy of Winchefier, the County of Soutbampion, the Town of Sbrewe/bury, and the County of Salicp, out of the Provifiens of an A:i made in the Eigbth Yesr of the Reign of bis late Majefly King George the Second, intituled, An Act for regulating the Quartering of Soldiers during the Tims of the Eiedions of Members to ferve in Parliament, 10 far as the fame relates to the Removal of Troops during zhe Elections of Members 10 firve in Parliament, for a limited Time.

An Aa for building a Stone Bridge crofs tbe River of Thames, from tbe Parijh of Ealing in the County of Middlefex, to the oppofite Shore, in the Haml.t of Kerw in the County of Surrey.
An $A C t$ to rovive and continue an $A R$, paffed in the Sixitb Year of the Reign of His prefent Majefty, intitaled, An AIt to regulate sbe Loading of Sbips with Coals in the Ports of Newecafle and Sunderland.

An Ala for the more eafy and spedy Recovery of Small Delts within the Parifhes of Brofeley, Benthall, Maitlsy, Barraw, Linley, Willey, Litte Wenlack, and Dawley, and an extra-parocbial Place, called Pofnall, in the County of Salip.
An AA: for making a Paflage :for Carriages from $S_{\text {pitial-Fields to Bijopofgate Street, in the County of }}$ Middifix, and for paving the fame, and for appro. prialing to ibofe Purpofes the Money arifen by Virtue nf an Act pafid in the Eighteenth Year of His prefint. Majeff; for applying tbe Sumn of Nine Thoufand Pounds to arife out of the Orpbans Fund for making fuch Paffage.

An Alt for amending the Pavement in, and for lighting fome of the Streits, Lanes, Ways, and Places, in the Parifes of Saint Margaret and Saint Fobn the Evangeliff, in Wefminfer, which are at prefent excluded from the Provifions of an Act paffed in the Elerenth Year of His prefent Majefty, intituled, An Aa ro amend and render more effectual feveral Aas made relating to paving, cleanfing, and lighting the Squares, Streets, Lanes, and otber Places ruitbin the City and Libcrty of Wefmispler, 'and Parts adjacent; and fir preventing Nuifances end Annoyances in and ncar the fime; and for making an Opening from Oriba do
freet; and widening fome Part of Wood Arett, and of Little Peter-freet.

An Act for amending, widening, asad kecping in Repair, the Road from Wre:Bann, in the Coun,'y of Denbigh, to Banbill, in the County of Cbeffer.

An Act for repairing and widening the Road from Tarporley, in the County Palatine of Cb fer, to Aifon Bridge, near Weverbam, in the jame Comity.

An Act for enlarging the Term ami Powers of fo much of an Act, made in the Stcind Year of the Netign of His prefent Majefy, intituled, An Acz jor repairing and widening the High Road leading from AB. borne, in the County of Derby, to the Towin of Leek, in the County of Stafford, and from Ryecroft Gate, upon Rufforn Common, to Congleton, in the County of Cheffer, and alfo the Road leading from Blytb Mar/h, in the County of Stafford, though Cheadle, Oakamocr, and Biore, to zbe Turnpike Rcad from Ahnborne ic'Buxton, near Tharp, intha Ccunty of Derby, as relates to the Diftrict of Road batween Ajbborne and Congleton, and for repairing the Road from the End of Abborne Church Yard to the Top of The Dig Street, in Abborne aforefaid.
An ALZ to enlarge ibe Term and Powers of an AEt, paffed in the Thirty-third Year of the Reign of King George the Second, for reparing the Roads from the Town of Brecon to the Parib of Brobury, and to Whitney Paffape, in the County of Hereford; and for building a Bridge over the River Wje, at Bredwardive Paflage, in the fame County; fo far as relates to fuch of the Roads, comprized in the faid Aat, as lie in the County of Hereford.
An AEt to enlarge tbe Term and Powers of an $A A$, prffed in the Second Year of His prefent Majefy, for repairing and widening the Road from the Turnpike Road at Wey Hill, in the County of Soutbampton, to the Turnpike Road at Lyde Way in the County of Wilts.
An Acz to continue the Term, and alter the Powers of an AIt, made in the Twenty-nintb Year of the Reign of bis late Majefy King George the Second, intituled, An Alt for repairing and widening the Roads leading from a Pond belonging to Henry Eyre, E/quire in be Parifs of White Parib, in the County of Wilts, to the Top of Dunswood Hill, and from thence, owir Great Bridge, and Middle Bridge, througb Romfey Infra, to Hundred Bridge, in the Coun'y of Siutbampton. and from thence to the County of the Torun of Southamptor.
An Act for onlarging the Term and Porvers of ant Alt made in the Firft 1 of the Reign of His prefent Majं Ay, intituled, An Aal for repairing and widening the Road from the Borougb of Appleby, in the County of Wefmorland, throug b the Tcwunfbip of Orton, to Kirby Kendall,' and from Orton to the Turnpithe Road near Shapp, and from Higlgate, ntar Tubaj, in a Part of the Highway betweens Appllely and Kirby Ken. dall, tbraugh ibe Town of Kirby Steven, to the Town of Market Brough, in the faid County.
