PROCLAMATION, For Pardoning Deferters from the Land Forces.

GEORGE R.

HEREAS divers Perfons duly inlifted, or in Pay as Soldiers in cer-tain Regiments and Military Corps, which have been fince difbanded or difembodied, and in other Regiments or Corps now fubfilting, have deferted Our Service, and thereby incurred the Penalties respectively inflicted for such Offence, by feveral Acts of Parliament passed for punifhing Mutiny and Defertion : And whereas We are gracioully difpoled to extend Our Royal Mercy to the faid Offenders, who may be hereafter ulefal to their Country in following their honeft and lawful Occupations, in cafe they are enabled thereto by receiving Our free Pardon; We have therefore thought fr, by and with the Advice of Our Privy Council, to iffue this Our Royal Proclamation; and We do hereby, for Us, Our Heirs and Succeffors, pardon and remit all and every fuch Offence and Offences of Defertion from any fuch Regiments or Military Corps, committed by any Perion or Per-fons, previous to the Date of this Our Royal Proclamation: And We do alfo releafe and difcharge the faid Offenders from all Profecutions, Imprifonments, and Penalties, commenced or incurred for or by Reafon of any such Offence or Offences. And whereas many of the faid Deferters have been apprehended at various Times, and committed for fafe Cultody to the feveral Gaols or Prifons belonging to the Counties, Towns, or Places, where fuch Deferters have been found or apprehended, to the End that they might be proceeded againft according to Law; the Names of which Deferters have been from Time to Time transmitted to Our Secretary at War for the Time being, purfuant to the Provisions of fuch Acts of Parliament made for punishing Mu-tiny and Defertion as aforefaid; We do hereby, by and with the Advice of Our faid Privy Council, declare Our farther Pleafure, and do will and require all and every Gaoler and Gaolers, Keeper and Keepers of any Gaol, Houfe of Correction, or Prifan, where any fuch Deferter or Deferters is or are in Cuffody, to discharge him or them forthwith, without Fee or Reward, upon receiving a Certificate or Certificates, under the Hand of Our Secretary at War for the Time being, that the Name or Names of fuch Deferter or Deferters do appear to him to have been transmitted to the War Office, pursuant to the Provisions of any of the faid Acts: And We do hereby further charge and command every fuch Gaoler or Keeper, within the Space of Seven Days after receiving any fuch Certificate as aforefaid, to make a Return to Our Secretary at War for the Time being, of what fuch Goaler or Keeper fhell have done in purfuance of fuch Certificate, and of this Our Royal Froclamation. Provided always, That nothing herein contained shall extend to dif-charge any Perfon or Perfons to in Custody for any fuch Offence of Defertion, who thall have been lawfully committed or detained in the Cultody of any fuch Gaoler or Keeper for any Crime, Caufe, or Matter, other than fuch Offence or Offences of Defertion.

Given at Our Court at St. James's, the Eleventh Day of June, One thousand feven hundred and eighty three, in the Twenty-third Year of Our Reign.

The King has been pleafed to order a Congé d'Elire to país the Great Seal, empowering the Dean and Chapter of the Cathedral Church of Dean and Chapter of the Cathoria Church of Brittol to elect a Bifhop of that See, the faine being void by the Translation of the Right Reverend Father in God Doctor Lewis Bagot, late Bifhop thereof, to the See of Norwich; and His Majelly has been pleafed; by His Royal Sign Manual, to recommend to the faid Dean and Chapter, the Reverend Christopher Wilson, Doctor in Divinity, One of the Canons Refidentiary of St. Paul's, to be by them elected Bishop of the faid See of Briftol.

The King has been pleafed to grant to the Re-verend Cyril Jackfon, Doctor in Divinity, the Place and Dignity of Dean of the Cathedral Church of Chrift, in the University of Oxford, void by the Translation of the Right Reverend Father in God Lewis, late Bishop of Bristol, to the See of Norwigh Norwich.
