Oats, Barley, and all other Species of Grain, being the Growth or Production of any of the faid United States of America, may (until further Order) be im. ported bv Britifh Subjects,' in Britifh Built Ships owned by His Majefly's Subjects, and navigated according to Law, from any Port of the faid United Stares of A.perica, to any of His Majelly's Welt India Iflanos, the Bahama Iflands, anu the Bermuda or Somers Illands; and thar Rum, Sugar, Mielaffes, Coffee, Cocoa Nuts, Ginger and Pimento, may (until further Order) be exported by Biitith Subjeets, in Britifh Built Ships, owned by His Majelty's Subjects, and navigated accoraing to Law, from any of the faid Mands, to any Port or Place within the faid United States, upon Payment of the fame Duties on Exportation, and fubject to the like Rules, Regulations, Securities and Reltrictions, as the fame Articles by Law are or may be fubject and liable to, If exported to any Britifh Colony or Plantation in America; and the Bonds and Securities herecofore required to be taken for fuch Ships carrying fuch Goods, fhall and may be cancelled and difcharged, upon the like Certinicates as are required by the above iecited Act to difcharge any. Bonds given in Great Britain for the due landing any other Goods in the faid United States of America.
And His Majetty is hereby further pleafed to order, with the Advice aforefaid, that the faid feveral Reg, laxions herein comprized, fhall, in all Refpects, be extended to fuch Ships and Goods as fhall have been brought and imported from, or may be entered and flipped for Exportation to, any Part of the faid United Staies, fince the faid 20th Day of this in flant December.

And tue Right Honorable the Lords Commiffioners of His Majefty's Treafury, and the Lords Commilfioners of the Admiralty, are to give the neceffary Directions herein as to them may refpectively appertain.
