**HIS** Majesty having been pleased, by His Royal Proclamation of the 31<sup>st</sup> of December last, to direct, that Passes of a new Form should be issued to all His Subjects trading in the Way of the Cruizers belonging to the Governments on the Coast of Barbary; My Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty do hereby give Notice, that, in Pursuance of the aforesaid Proclamation, Passes of a new Form will be ready to be issued at this Office, from the First Day of next Month, to such Persons as shall apply for them; and at His Majesty's Foreign Colonies and Plantations, as soon as conveniently may be: But that such Passes of the old Form as have been issued, will, nevertheless, continue in Force till the 31<sup>st</sup> of December next.
