We have fudied to hew a fincere Difpofition to confirm them by a liberal Imitation; and we hall be zealous to concur in diffufing throughout every Part of the Kingdom the fuccersfal Influence of to happy an Example. Convinced as we are of the Importance to this Kingdon of a feady and perimanent Adminiftration, it is our ardent Wifh that His-Majefty may long continue your Grace in the Government of Ireland.
