of any of the faid Tools, or knowingly fufter the fame to be tone, he fhall forfeit ONE HUNDRED POUNDS,' to be recovered as aforefaid, and alfo forfeit his Office, and be incapable of any Office under His Majefty.

One Moiety of the Forfeitures fhall be applied to the Ufe of His Majefty, and the other Moiety to thie Ufe of the Perfon who fhall fue for the fame.

${ }^{p}$U $B$ IC Notice is bereby given, Tbat, by an $A a$ palfed the laft Seffon of Parliament, "For grant"ing to His Majefy, certain additional Rates of "Poftage, for Conveyance of Letters and Packets by "tbe Poff within the King dont of Great Britain, and "for further preventing Frauds and Abufes in relation "to tha fending and receiving of Letters and Packets "free from Poffage;" It is, amongft other Things, enacted,

That from and after the 31 l Intlant, Letters and Packets, to and from Places, not exceeding one Poft Stage, within Great-Britain, fhall pay, in Addition to the prefent Rate of Poftace, Single id. Double 2 d . Treble 3 d . and the Ounce 4 d .

That Letters and Packets above one, and not exceeding two Poft Stages, within-England, fhall pay in Addition, Single . 1 d . and fo in Proportion.

That Letters and Packets above two Poft Stages, and not exceeding 80 Miles, within England, Thall pay in Addition, Single id. and fo in Proportion.

That Letters and rackets above 80, and not exceeding 150 Miles, within England, hall pay in Addition, Singlestd. and fo in Proportion.

That Letters and Packets above 150 Miles, within England, fhall pay in Addition, Single 2 d . and fo in Proportion.

That Letters and Packets to or from the General Port-Office in London, to or from the City of Edinburgh, Dumfries and Cockburnfpeth, fhall pay in Addition, Single Id, and fo in Proportion.

That Letters and Packets above one Poot Stage, and not exceeding 50 Miles, within Scotland, Rall pay in Addition, single Id. and fo in Proportion.

That Letters and Packets above 50 , and not exceeding 80 Miles, within Scorland, hall pay in Addition, Single Id. and fo in Proportion.

That Letters and Packets above 80, and not exceeding 150 Miles, within Scotland, fhall pay in Addition, Single 1 d . and fo in Proportion.

That Letters and Packets above 150 Miles, within Scotland, fhall pay in Addition, Single 2 d . and fo in Proportion.

It is provided, that no Letter or Packet to or from Glafgow, or the intermediate Places by Carlifle, not paffing through London, fhall pay an bigher Rate than if fent through Edinburgh to or from Glafgow; : and that no Letter or Packet fent to or from Edinburgh, or any intermediate Place in England and Scotland, North of London, shall pay an higher Rate than 7 d . for a Single Letter, and fo in Proportion.

It is further provided, that no Letter or Packet, together with its Contents, fhall be taxed at an higher Rate than as a Treble Letter, unlefs it hall weigh an Ounce, when it fhall be rated as Four Single Letters; and every Quarter of an Ounce above that Weight fhall be-charged as a Single Letter.

It is likewife enacted, that from and after the lat Sefion of Parliament, no Letter of Packet fent by Poft, within Great Britain, directed by
any Member of either Houfe of Parliament, thall be exempted from the Duty of Poftage, unlefs the whole Superifription thereof fhall be of the Handwriting of the Member, and fhall have endorfed thereon, in the fame Hand-writing, the Name of the Member, Poft Town from whence the fame is to be fent, and the Day, Month, and Year, when put into the Poft Office, the Day of the Month to be in Words at length; and unlefs every fach Letter and Packet fhall be put into the General, or other Poft-Office, or into a Receiving Houfe, on the Day of the Date put upon fuch Letter on Packet: And no Letter or Packet directed to any fuch Member thall be exempted from the. Duty of Poftage, unlefs fuch as fhall, duting the Sitting of Parliament, or within Forty Days before, or Eorty Days after any Summons or Prorogation thereof, be direted to any fuch Member, at the Place where he fhall actually be at the Time of the Delivery thereof, or at his ufual Place of Refidence in London, or at the Houfe, or Lobby of the Houfe of Parliament, of which he is a Member.
It is further enacted, that all Perions who, by Virtue of their Offices, fend and receive Letters and Packets free of Potiage, thall iend and receive them free, in the Manner, and under fuch Reftrictions, as any Member of Parliament.

It is alfo enacted, that if any Perfon fhall forge or counterfeit the Hand-writing of any Yerfon whatfoever, in the Superfcription of any Letter or Packet, in order to avoid the Payment of Poftage, or fhall forge, counterfeit, or alter, or procure to be done, the Date upon fuch Superfcription, or thall write; and fend by Poft, or caufe to be done, any Letter or Packet, the superfcription or Cover whereof fhall be forged or counterfeited, or the Date thereon altered, in order to avoid the Duty of Poitage, knowing the - fame to be forged, counterfeited, or altered, every Perfon fo offending, thall be deemed guilty of Felony, and fhall be tranfported for Seven Years.

$B^{T}$ ant AIE of the laft, and alfo one of the prefent Sefion of Parliament, for eflablifhing certain Regulations concerning the Portage and Conveyance of Letters and Packets by the Poift between Great Britain and Ireland, to take Place on the 1 if of Auguft next, all Letters and Packets are to be charged and paid for according to the prefent Rates of Pofage in Great Britain, and the Rates effablifhed by the ALE of Parliansent in Ireland, except to and from certain Perfons whbo, by Virtue of the refpective Offices in Great Britain and Ireland, now fend and receive Letters and Packets fres from the Duty of Poftage, pravided that all fuch Letters and Packgis fo Sent paall relate to the Bufonefs of tbeir refpective Offices, and that there Ball be certified on the Outfide of fuch Letticis and Packets, under the Hand Writing of fuch Oficers rifpectively to be On His Majelly's Service, and that fucis Letters and Packets Ball be fealed witith tbe Scol'of the Oficc, or Officer ending the fame. And in Cafe any fict Offe cers fall recive under. Cover to them any Letters or Packets intended for or direfled to otber Perfons, all fuch Officers are requived to fend the fame to the General Pof Clfice in London, or Dublir, in order that juch Letters and Packets may be charged with the Duty of
