A Proclamation Requiring the Members of both Houfes of Parliament to give their Attendance upon the Fiftenth day of Fanuary next.

CHARLES R.

Hereas the Kings mak Encellent Majefty by His Royal Proclamation of the Six and twentieth day of October 14st .

And twentiefd day of October tait, did give Notice, That be intended an Adjumment of bob Houfes of Par-lisment, from the Third day of December inflant, (being the day prefixed for their Affembly) until the Equith day of April next; And whereas His Majefty upon the faid Third day of December, did by Moffage feverally 10 each Houfe of Parliament, Signifie, That (for divers Weighty Confiderations) His Majefty day think fit to wet the faid Harfes (over the where laid think fit to meet the faid Houfes foozer than the faid Faurub day of April 5 And that therefore His Ricu fure pas, That the faid Houfes of Parliament fhould be lewenly Aljourned until the Fasteenth day of Ja-muary next; To which time both Houfes were Ad. Journed accordingly. Of all which His Majesty's pra-ciously pleyfed that all perfons concerned should have simily natice; and doch therefore hereby Publish and make known the fam. And His Majesty being defi-rous (in respect of several important Matters in-tended to be Debated and Considered) to have on the faid Fifteenth d y of January, a full Asters in the Kombers of both Houses of Parliament, hath (with the Aduite of His Privy Council) thought fits Re-quire, and doth hereby Require and Command all and think fit to meet the faid Houfes fooner than the faid. quire, and dush hereby Require and Command all and every the Lords Spiritual and Temporal of this Realm, and the Knights, Citizens and Burgeffes of the Houfe of Commons, to give their Attendance at Weltmin-ther on the faid Eifteenth day of January next. And His Majefly doth expect a ready Conformity to this His Royal Willand Pleafure.

Given at Our Court at Whitehall the 7th day of D cember 1677. in the Nine and twentieth year ot Our Reign.
