Cuftom-Houfe, London, August 5, 1786. HEREAS by an Act paffed in the Twenty-W fixth Year of the Reign of His prefent Ma-jefty, intituled, "An Act for the further Increase and Encouragement of Shipping and Navigation," it is (amongst other Things) enacled, That all and every Ship or Vessel having a Deck, or being of the Burthen of Fifteen Tons or upwards, belonging to any of His Majefty's Subjects in Great Britain, or Guernfey, Jerfey, and the Ifle of Man, or of any of the Colonies, Plantations, Iflands or Territories in Afia, Africa, or America, which now belong, or, at the Time of building fuch Ships or Veffels, did be-long, or which may hereafter belong to, or be in the Poffeffion of His Majefty, His Heirs, or Succeffors, (except Lighters, Barges, Boats or Veffels ufed folely in Rivers of Inland Navigation) shall be registered in the Manner therein mentioned; and the Perfon or Perfons claiming Property therein, fhall caufe the fame to be registered, and shall obtain a Certificate of fuch Registry from the Collector and Comptroller of His Majesty's Customs in Great Britain, or the Isle of Man, or from the Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, or Commander in Chief and Principal Offi-cer or Officers of His Majefty's Revenue of Cuftoms refiding in the Iflands of Guernfey or Jerfey, or in any of the aforefaid Colonies, Piantations, Iflands or Territories respectively, according to the Form and in the Manner described in the faid Act.

And whereas the Commiffioners of His Majefty's Cultoms are by the faid Act authorized and required, within a certain reafonable Time, as may be beft adapted to the Diftance of the Ports to which the Ships and Veffels, owned by His Majefty's Subjects, fhall refpectively belong, to give public Notice of the Time when fuch Certificates will be ready to be granted to fuch Ships or Veffels as fhall be legally entitled thereunto;

The faid Commissioners of His Majesty's Customs do hereby give Notice, That Certificates of Registry will be ready to be granted, according to the Form and in the Manner directed by the faid Act, to every fuch Ship or Vessel at and from the feveral and respective Times hereafter mentioned;
