And at the End of One Month from the Date of the faid ieveral and respective Periods before-mentioned, it is hereby declared, that the faid Notice will expire.

And for the Information of all Parties concerned, the following *particular* Claufes of the faid Act are published, viz,

In respect to

A Ship or Veffel first arriving, after the Expiration of the faid Notice, at a Port to which she belongs.

" No Ship or Veffel, which by this Act is directed " to be hereafter registered, or which is directed, inftead of the Register now required by Law, to " take out a new Register according to the Form " and in the Manner described in the faid Act, " shall be permitted, after her first Arrival at the " Port to which the belongs at the Expiration of the "Notice before-mentioned, to clear Outwards to "Foreign Parts or Coaffwife, or to proceed to Sea " in order to fifh on the Coafts, or for any other "Purpofe whatever as a British Ship or Vessel, or shall be in any wife entitled to the Privileges of a " British Ship or Veffel, unless the Owner or Owners thereof shall have obtained a Certificate according " to the Form and in the Manner directed by the " faid Act; and in cafe any fuch Ship or Vefiel shall depart from fuch Port without being registered, c 6 and without having obtained a Certificate as afore-" faid, every fuch Ship or Veffel shall be subject to "Forfeiture, and also all the Guns, Furniture, Am-munition, Tackle and Apparel to such Ship or " Veffel belonging."

A fquare-rigged Ship or Veffel fo arriving at a Port within Twenty Leagues of the Port to which fhe belongs; or *not* being fquare-rigged, fo arriving at any Port to which fhe does not belong.

" If, after the Expiration of the Notice aforefaid, " any Ship or Veflel (being square-rigged) shall be found in any Port within the Distance of Twenty " Leagues by Water from the Port to which the be-" longs; or if any Vessel, not being square-rigged, " be found within any Port other than that to which " fhe belongs, without having obtained the Certificate of Registry," (directed by the faid Act) " it shall and may be lawful to and for the Principal Officer << or Officers of fuch Port, and he or they is and are " hereby required to detain fuch Ship or Veffel, " until the Mafler or other Perfon having or taking " the Charge or Command thereof fhall, if fuch "Ship or Veffel be under the Burthen of Fifty " Tons, give Security by Bond, in the Penalty of " Fifty Pounds, in Manner directed by the faid Act : " and if such Ship or Veffel shall exceed the Burthen " of Fifty Tons, and shall not exceed that of One " Hundred Tons, then until the Mafter or other Perfon having or taking the Charge or Command " the eof shall in like Manner give Security by "Bond in the Penalty of One Hundred Pounds; " and if fuch Ship or Vefiel shall exceed the Burthen " of One Hundred Tons, then until the Master or " other Perion having or taking the Charge or Com-" mard thereof shall, together with One sufficient " Security (to be approved by such Principal Of-" ficer or Officers) give Bond to His Majefty, His

" Heirs and Succeffors, to be taken by fuch Officer " or Officers, in the Penalty of Two Hundred Pounds, with Condition, that fuch Master or other Person so having or taking the Charge or Com-.... mand of every fuch Ship or Veffel, shall repair with her as foon as conveniently may be (or, being " employed in the Fishery on the Banks of Newfoundland and Parts adjacent, at the End of the Fishing Seafon) to the Port to which she belongs, " and there caule her to be registered, and procure a Certificate of fuch Registry, in the rorm and Manner directed by the faid Act, and produce " and deliver to fuch Officer or Officers fuch Certificate of Registry, within the 'Time limited in the Condition of such Bond; which Limitation of Time fuch Officer or Officers is and are hereby authorized to fix, according to the Diftance which fuch Ship or Vefiel may be from the Port to which fhe belongs, and the Nature of the Voyage in which fhe may then be engaged ; and on Failure of producing and delivering fuch Certificate as atorefaid, fuch Bond shall be forseited: But if fuch Certificate shall be produced and delivered " to fuch Officer or Officers, within the Time fo " limited in the Bond, fuch Bond fhall be void and of none Effect, and he or they is and are hereby " authorized and required to cancel the fame."

A fquare-rigged Ship or Veffel fo arriving at a Port diftant more than Twenty Leagues from the Port to which fhe belongs.

" In cafe any fquare-rigged Ship or Veffel, after " the Expiration of the Notice aforefaid, fhall be " found in any Port diftant more than Twenty" Leagues by Water from the Port to which she be-longs, or that the Water, at the Entrance of the " Port to which fuch Ship or Veffel belongs, shall " be fo fhallow as not to admit her Entrance into the fame without endangering the Safety of fuch Ship " or Vefiel, the Master, or other Person having the " Charge or Command of fuch Ship or Veffel, Ihall, " within Forty-eight Hours after his Arrival at fuch Port as aforefaid, make known his Arrival to the Collector and Comptroller of the Cuftoms or other " Principal Officer of fuch Port, and shall require fuch Collector and Comptroller, or other Principal Officer, to cauje his Ship or Veffel to be furveyed by the proper Officer at fuch Port, who fhall be " appointed purfuant to the Directions of the faid Act, to furvey Ships and Veffels there, and who fhall accordingly make a perfect and accurate Survey thereof, and certify the feveral Particulars thereof in the Manner directed by the faid Act; 66 " and fuch Collector and Comptroller, or other Principal Officer, shall immediately transmit the faid Certificate of Survey to the Perform authorized to register Ships and Vesfels, and grant Certificates of Registry at the Port to which fuch Ship or Vessel belongs, who thereupon, and upon all the other Requisites of the faid Act being complied " " " with, shall register such Ship or Vessel, and grant " a Certificate of the Registry thereof, purluant to " the faid Act. And it shall and may be lawful to and " for the Collector and Comptroller, or other Principal Officer or Officers of the Cuftoms in the Port where fuch Ship or Veffel fhall be fo found, and he " or they are hereby authorized and required to de-" tain fuch Ship or Veffel, until a perfect and accu-" rate Survey thereof shall be made in Manner " directed by the faid Act."

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
