Senfible of the very great Bleflings we enjoy under your Majefly's Government, and of the high Obligations we owe to your Majesty's Illustrious House, we view the late daring and violent Attack with Horror and Deteftation, and we most humbly intreat your Majesty's Permission to take this Opportunity to renew our fincere Professions of Duty, Loyalty and Attachment to your Majesty's Sacred Person and Government, and to your Royal and Illustrious Houfe; and to add, that it is, and ever will be, our most fervent Prayer, that the fame Divine Providence, which has hitherto shielded and protected your Sacred Perfon, may long preferve and continue your Majefly to a grateful and dutiful People, and make your Reign prosperous and happy.
