Constantinople, January 11.

The Plague has again broken out, with a Violence altogether unusual in this Season of the Year, in different Parts of Constantinople, and in the Suburb of Haskoy, mostly inhabited by Jews, in the Neighbourhood of the Naval Arsenal. It is hoped, however, that the present very cold Weather may check the Progress of the Contagion.

St. Petersburg, January 19.

Her Imperial Majesty, with her Suite, set off Yesterday Morning at about Nine o'Clock from Czarco-Zelo, on her intended Tour.

The Treaty of Commerce between this Court and that of Naples was signed at Czarco-Zelo by the respective Plenipotentiaries Yesterday Evening.

Dresden, January 21.

The Distemper, which had broken out among the Horned Cattle in the Village and Neighbourhood of Stolpen, has entirely disappeared; in Consequence of which the Troops, which were stationed to prevent the spreading of the Infection, have been withdrawn.

Nice, January 25.

Yesterday died here John Birkbeck, Esq; His Britannick Majesty's Consul.

Turin, January 30.

His Sardinian Majesty has appointed the Count de St. André, Commandant at Nice, to be Viceroy of Sardinia.
