### Whiteball, April 3.

HE King has been pleafed to grant to the Honourable John Luttrell, of New Hall in the County of Effex, and his Iffue, His Royal Licence and Authority to assume and take the Surname and Arms of Olmius, as a Mark of Respect to the Memory of his Father-in-Law, the Right Honourable John Olmius, Baron Waltham, of Phillips Town in the Kingdom of Iteland, late of Patiswick Hall and Braintree, in the faid County of Effex, deceafed, with whole only Daughter Elizabeth the faid John Luttrell fome Time fince intermarried; fuch Arms being first duly ex-emplified according to the Laws of Arms, and re-torded in the Heralds Office; and His Majefty has also been pleased to order that this His Concession and Declaration be registered in His College of Arms.

#### Edinburgh, March 28.

This Day came on at the Palace of Holyrood Houfe, in confequence of His Majefty's Proclamation, the Election of Two Peers of Scotland, to fit and vote in the House of Peers of the prefent Parliament of Great Britain, in the Room of William Duke of Queensberry, and James Earl of Abercorn, created Peers of Great Britain, when Dunbar Earl of Sel-kirk, and George Lord Kinnaird, were elected.
