made up to any fixed Period in the Year ; in which Cale they shall be delivered within Three Months of the usual annual Time of the Determination of each Account respectively; and in case such Monies shall have been iffued for Services to be performed in any Part of Europe out of this Kingdom, then the Vouchers shall be delivered within Four Months of the Expiration of each Year's Ac-, counts; if in the West Indies, the Continent of America, or in Africa, within Six Months after the Expiration of each Year's Accounts; and if in the East Indies, within Twelve Months after the Expiration of each Year's Accounts; unlefs it shall in each and every Cafe be made appear to the Satisfaction of the Commissioners of the Treasury, that the Failure of transmitting the fame, within the Periods beforementioned, was unavoidable; in which Cafe fuch further Delay may be granted by Warrant under the Hands of the Commissioners of the Treasury, or any Three of them, as they shall judge reafonable; and in fuch Cafes the Vouchers thall be delivered at the Expiration of the Term of Delay fo granted, on Pain, upon Failure in any of the abovementioned Cafes, of paying fuch Fine to His Majefly as the Court of Exchequer, on Application made to them, shall think fit to fet and impose; which Fine the faid Court is hereby authorized and impowered to fet and impose accordingly.

SECTION XXII. Provided always, and be it enacted, that when any Sub-Accountant or Sub-Accountants shall transmit to the Commissioners, to be appointed under the Authority of this Act, a fufficient and faisfactory Difcharge from the Principal Officers of the Ordnance, the Com-miffioners of His Majefly's Navy, the Commiffioners for Victualling His Majefly's Navy, or the Com-miffioners for Sick and Hurt, for any Monies he or they thall have received in the faid Departments Guarally, the faid Commiffioners thall transfinit a feverally, the faid Commissioners shall transmit a Duplicate of the fame to His Majefty's Remem-brancer in the Court of Exchequer, who fhall forthwith strike out the Name or Names of such Sub-Accountant or Sub-Accountants from the Impreft Roll; and fuch Sub-Accountant or Sub-Accountants shall from thenceforth be discharged From any other or further Account for the fame.
