The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

THIS Day his Royal Highness the Duke of York was, by His Majesty's Command, introduced into the Privy Council by the Right Honourable Earl-Camden, Lord President, where his Royal Highness took his Place at the upper End of the Board, on His Majesty's Left Hand.

The King has been pleased, by Letters Patent under the Great Seal of Great Britain, to erect the Province of Nova Scotia into a Bishop's See, and to name and appoint the Reverend Charles Inglis, Doctor in Divinity, to be Bishop of the said See.

The King has been pleased to grant unto Elizabeth Phelps, of Withy Bush House, in the County of Pembroke, Widow, and her Issue, His Royal Licence and Authority to assume and take the Surname and bear the Arms of Martin only, (such Arms being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms, and recorded in the Heralds-Office,) pursuant to the last Will and Testament of her Brother Sparks Martin, late of Withy Bush House aforesaid, Esq; deceased; and also to order that this His Majesty's Concession and Declaration be registered in His College of Arms.
