The King has been pleased to order a Congé d'Elire to pass the Great Seal, empowering the Dean and Chapter of the Cathedral Church of Carlisle to elect a Bishop of that See, the same being void by the Death of the Right Reverend Father in God Doctor Edmund Law, late Bishop thereof; and His Majesty has also been pleased, by His Royal Sign Manual, to recommend to the said Dean and Chapter the Reverend John Douglas, Doctor in Divinity, Canon Residentiary of the Cathedral Church of St. Paul, London, and one of His Majesty's Chaplains in Ordinary, to be by them elected Bishop of the said See of Carlisle.
