At the General Quarter Session of the Peace of our Lord the King, holden for the City of London, at the Guildhall within the said City, on Monday the Twenty-second Day of October, in the Twenty-seventh Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Third, King of Great Britain, &c. before Thomas Lumby, Esquire, Mayor of the City of London, James Addis, one of His Maj. s. Serjeants at Law, Recorder of the said City, John Bayell, Esquire, William Newman, Esquire, George Mackenzie Macclay, Esquire, Alderman of the said City, and others their Fellowes, Justices of our said Lord the King, assynd to keep the Peace of our said Lord the King, within the said City, and also to hear and determine divers Felonies, Trespasses, and other Misdemeanors committed within the said City.
