The Packets will leave at Barbadoes all Letters for the Leeuvard Islands, which will be conveyed by a Brig to Dominica, Antigua and St. Kitt's, where they will be delivered to the English Packets upon their Arrival ifrom Grenada, and forwarded with the rest to Jamaica and England.

This is a temporary Plan, 'till another upon a larger Scale can be carried into Effect.
