A PROCLAMATION,

For recalling and probibiting Seamen from ferving Foreign Princes and States.

GEORGE R.

HEREAS it hath been reprefented unto Us, That Attempts are made to entice Mariners and Seafaring Men, Our Natural-born Subjects, to enter

into the Service of Foreign Princes and States, contrary to their Duty to Us, and without Regard to the perfect Amity now fubfifting between Us and all the other Powers of Europe; We have therefore thought it neceffary, by and with the Advice of Our Privy Council, to publish this Our Royal Proclamation, and do hereby firiftly charge and command all Mafters of Ships, Pilots, Mariners, Seamen, Shipwrights, and other Seafaring Men, whatfoever and wherefo-ever (being Our Natural-born Subjects,) who may have entered into the Pay or Service of any Foreign Prince or State, or do ferve in any Foreign Ship or Veffel, without Our Special Licence and Authority in that Behalf heretofore obtained, that forthwith they and every of them do (according to their known and bounden Duty and Allegiance) withdraw them-felves, depart from and quit fuch Foreign Services, and return Home to their Native Countries : And further, We do hereby firicily prohibit and forbid all Masters of Ships, Pilots, Mariners, Seamen, Shipwrights, and other Seafaring Men whatloever (being Our Natural-born Subjects,) from entering, and do charge and command them, and every of them, from henceforth to forbear to enter themselves into the Pay or Service of any Foreign Prince or State, or to ferve in any Foreign Ship or Veffel whatfoever, without Our Special Licence first had and obtained in that Behalf; to all which We expect due Obedience and exact Conformity: And We do hereby publish and declare, That the Offenders to the con-trary shall not only incur Our just Displeasure, but be proceeded against for their Output Dupleante, but be utmost Severities of the Law : And We do hereby de-clare, That if any such Masters of Ships, Pilots, Mariners, Seamen, Shipwrights, or other Seafaring Men (being Our Subjects,) shall be taken in any Foreign Service by the Turks, Algerines, or any

others, they fuall not be reclaimed by Us as Subjects of Great Britain.

Given at Our Court at the Queen's House, the Twenty-fecond Day of March, One thousand feven hundred and eighty-eight, in the Twentyeighth Year of Our Reign.

Authentic Intelligence is received here by the Health Office, that the Plague has broken out at Algiers, and also that it raged very violently at Constantinople.

Hamburgh, March 11. On the 8th Instant died at Ritzebuttel, Senator Vincent Matsen, Esq; and Bailli of that Place, in the Sixty-third Year of his Age, of an apoplectick: Fit.

Vienna, March 12. Letters from Trieste mention that his Imperial Majesty arrived there on the 4th instant, passed the fucceeding Day in reviewing the Works which have been confiructed there for the Defence of the Port, and fet out on the 6th for Fiume.

Admirally-Office, March 22, 1788. DUrfuant to an Act of Parliament passed in the Twenty-fixth Year of His late Majesty's Reign, this is to give Notice to the Concerned, that Infor-mation has been fent to this Office, That the Ship Cornelis, whereof Meyndext Seijmeufz was Mafter, bound from Cette to Amsterdam in Holland, with a Cargo of Wine, Almonds, Verdigreafe, &c. was, on the 7th inftant, in a hard Gale of Wind, driven on Shore near Biding Gap, in the County of Suffex, and broken to Pieces, and that all the Crew except Peter Heywrick, late a Seaman on Board the faid Ph. Stephens. Ship, were drowned.
