

## From Tuefday May 6, to Saturday May 10, 1788.

## Westminster, May 8.

HIS Day the Lords being met, a Meffage was fent to the Honourable Houfe of Commons by Mr. Quarme, Yeoman Usher of the Black Rod, acquainting them, that The Lords, authorized by virtue of His Majefty's Commission, for declaring His Royal Assent to several Asts agreed upon by both Houses, do desire the intendiate Attendance of this Honourable House in the House of Peers, to bear the Commission read; and the Commons being come thither, the faid Commission, impowering His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales, the Lord Archbifhop of Canterbury, the Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain, the Lord Prefident of the Council, and feveral other Lords, to declare and notify the Royal Affent to the faid Acts, was read accordingly, and the Royal Affent given to

An Act for repealing an Act made in the Second and Third Years of the Reign of King Edward the Sixth, intituled, An Act against the carrying of White Ashes out of the Realm.

An Act for raifing further Sums of Money for the better Relief of the Poor of the City and County of the City of Exon, and to explain and amend an Act paffed in the Twenty-fifth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majefty, for rendering more effectual feveral AAs of Parliament for creeting Hospitals and Work-boufes within the Said City and County for the better employing and maintaining the Poor there.

An Ast for rebuilding the Bridge over the River Rea at the Town of Birmingham, called Deritend Bridge, and widening the Avenues thereto, and for -widening and varying the Course of the said River .near the faid Bridge, and making a Weir and other neceffary Works; to prevent the lower Part of the faid Town from being overflowed.

An Act for enlarging and improving the Harbour of Leith, for making a new Bason, Quays, Wharfs or Docks, for building Warehouses, for making new Roads and widening others leading to and from the faid Harbour, and for impowering the Lord Provoft, Magiftrates and Council of the City of Edinburgh to purchase Lands, Houses and Areas, and to borrow Money for these Purposes.

An Act for pawing the Footways, and cleanfing, lighting and watching the Streets and other public

Passages and Places within the Borough of Hertford, and removing and preventing Obstructions, Nuisances and Annoyances therein.

An Act for the better pawing, cleanfing and light-ing the Town of Cambridge, for r. moving and preventing Obstructions and Annoyances, and for widening the Streets, Lanes and other Passages within the faid Town.

An Act for supplying with Water the Town of South Shields and Parts adjacent, and the Shipping reforting to the faid Town.

An Act for rebuilding the Parifb Church of Pad-dington, in the County of Middlefex, and for en-larging the Church yard of the faid Parifb.

An Act for making and maintaining a navigable Canal from Pentre Rock, near the Town of Flint, to

Greenfield, in the County of Flint. An Act for continuing the Term and altering and enlarging the Powers of Three Acts, paffed in the Twenty fixth and Twenty-feventh Years of the Reign of His late Majefty, and in the Twelfth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majefty for repairing feveral Roads leading into the City of Glafgow, fo far as relates to that Part of the Road from the City of Glasgow to the Town of Dumbarton, which leads through the County to the Town of Dumbarton.

An Act to continue the Term and Powers of an A&, paffed in the Ninth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majefty King George the Third, for repairing and widening the Road from Maidstone through Debtling to Key-fireet, in the Parishes of Borden and Bobbing, in the County of Kent.

An Act for continuing the Term and warging fame of the Provisions of an Act of the Sevent's Year of His prefent Majesty, for repairing and widening the Road from Marchwiel, in the County of Denbigh, Koaa from Marchowski, in the County of Deholgs, through Bangor, Worthenbury and Hanmer, in the County of Flint, to a Houfe in the Polfeffion of Thomas Jenks in Dodington, in the Parish of Whit-church, in the County of Salop, and from Bangor aforefaid to Malpas, in the County of Chefter, and from Redbrook to Hampton, in the faid County of Salop.

An Act for continuing the Term and Powers of Two Acts, paffed in the Eighteenth Year of the Reign of His late Majefly King George the Second, and the Seventh Year of the Reign of His prefint Majefly, for repairing the Road leading from the Town of Kingfton upon Hull to and through the Town of Anlaby, and from thence to the Town of Kirk Ella, in the County of the faid Town of Kingfton upon Hull.

An AA for more effectually repairing the Roads leading from Pool through Ofweftry to Wrexham; fross
