Vienna, May 3.

According to Accounts received from Prince Lichtenstein of the 26th of April, an Attempt was made by the Auftrians, on the 25th, to florm Dubicza, but they were repulfed as they were entering the Breach which they had made. In return, the Turks having received a Reinforcement, which augmented the Garrifon to the Number of 12,000 Men, they fallied out, and attacked the Auftrians in their Trenches. A general Action then commenced, which lasted Three Hours, and though the Austrians were victorious, Prince Lichtenstein thought proper (all his Works being destroyed) to raife the Siege, and in the Night of the 25th he croffed the Unna, and encamped on the Heights between Dubicza and Bacin, to cover the Auftrian Territories from the Incurfions of the Enemy.
